

WOAH, WHAT?

"Panthers" are not a distinct species, but a color variation attributed to big cats who have dark fur.

The Genus: Panthera refers to an array of big cats including tigers and lions who have similar cranial characteristics.

MELANIN

Melanin are defined by natural black and brown skin pigments. This color variation is found in both animals and humans.



LEOPARD & JAGUAR

Black Panthers are leopards and jaguars with darker pigmentations. Other big and wild cats can also be called "panthers" because of their black coats or black spots set against their darker-colored fur.
