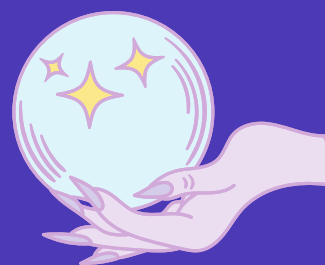

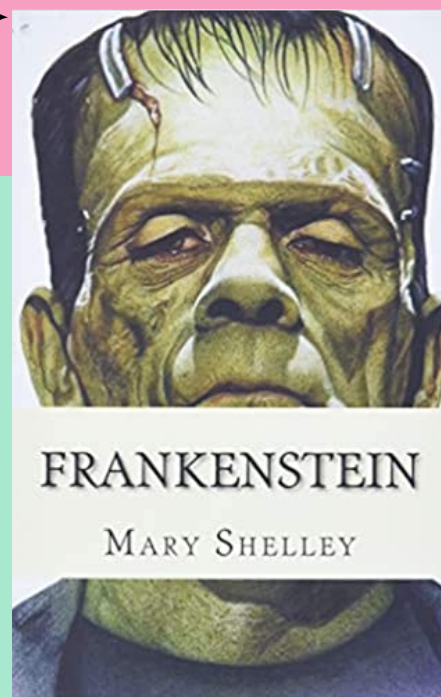

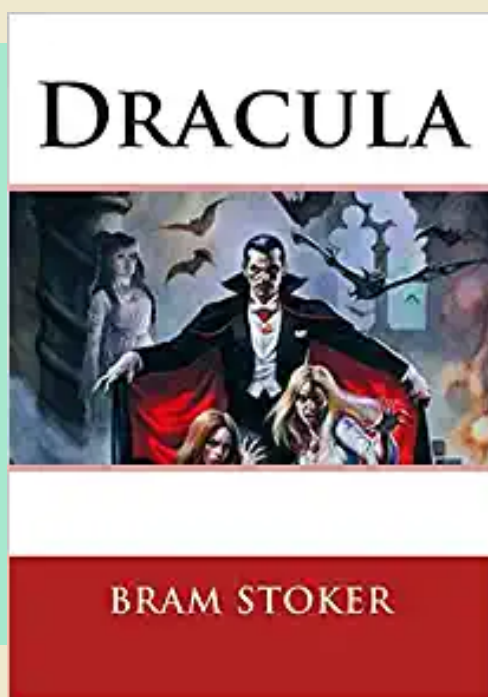
## A HOWL
