Student Fees

Tuition is due on either the 1st or 15th of the month, whichever date you choose when registering. A \$10 fee will be assessed if payment is more than 10 days late. There are no refunds for missed classes or dropping a class in the middle of a billing cycle. Tuition over 30 days late will receive a warning, over 60 days late and student is ineligible to attend classes until balance is current.

Clogging Classes

- \$30 One-time Registration Fee per student
1 On the Floor t-shirt included with each student registration
- \$30 Monthly cost per student, per class
- \$20 Monthly cost for each additional class for the same student

Additional dance styles

- \$20 Creative Movement, 30 minutes weekly
- \$30 Irish Dance, 60 minutes weekly

Discounts – applies to clogging classes only

- 10% off total for 2 students in the same family

Studio Rules

Dress Code

Students should wear comfortable clothes that do not drag the ground (as clothing could get caught in your taps). If you don't have clogging shoes yet, wear non-marking shoes that will stay on your feet.

Rules

1. **Discipline:** While clogging is intended to be a fun activity for everyone, we must still maintain discipline at the studio, in class, and at performances. There is to be absolutely no playing in the studio or lobby area, or on the grounds of the studio. Due to insurance requirements, this is strictly enforced! The lobby area is for dancers to wait for their class and for parents to observe classes and wait for their students. Please keep your children under control while at the studio. NO DANCING IN THE LOBBY, NO PLAYING IN THE WATER FOUNTAIN OR RESTROOMS, NO CLIMBING ON THE CHAIRS OR BENCHES, NO RUNNING OR PLAYING OUTSIDE.
2. **Shoes:** Clogging shoes should not be worn outside the studio or in the lobby and restroom areas.
3. **Workshops:** There are times when we receive information about workshops being taught within a reasonable travel area. We will keep this information in the lobby area and keep you updated as to which ones those in our group plan to participate in. We encourage you to take advantage of this learning experience from other qualified instructors from all over the country. We will also host workshops from time to time and hope you will take advantage of these learning opportunities!
4. **Parent Conferences** are available at your request or the request of an instructor. Please schedule these ahead of time. Classes are taught back-to-back and there is no time after class to meet with parents if the instructor has another class. Instructors are happy to talk with parents during free time at the studio.
5. **General Information**
 - Cloggers are welcome to attend more than one class. Advanced students are encouraged to attend other class levels as well in order to help and mentor younger/less experienced dancers.
 - There will be recitals periodically, which dancers are encouraged to participate in. Information about recitals will be given during regular classes.
 - Exhibition team members will be performing throughout the year and information will be given as far ahead as possible.

Clogging Shoe Information

All shoes should be white with Buck Taps. There are several options available, depending on a dancer's age and level of experience. All of the styles listed below (except the Keds-style sneaker) are available from Carl's Clogging Supply, <https://carls-clogging-supplies.myshopify.com>.



This is the least expensive option. We recommend these for dancers just getting into clogging, especially younger cloggers that aren't on the Exhibition or Competition teams, as they grow out of shoes so quickly. They are basically just **White** Keds-style sneakers that are available everywhere. You will purchase the shoes and the **Buck Taps** (\$15/set) separately. The taps can be attached to the sneakers with Shoe Goo (or other adhesive silicone product). We can help you with assembly upon request.



This is an entry-level leather clogging shoe. This particular model is the Freestyler. All sizes are available in medium and wide widths. Order the same size you wear in a street shoe. You will need to order **White** with **Buck Taps** installed.

This is the Signature Split Sole model. Splits are required for any toe work and are highly recommended if you are on the Exhibition or Competition teams. This shoe does not come in Men's sizes and is medium width only. The Splits run a little snug, so order up a half-size. Shoes are leather all around. Order **White** with **Buck Taps** installed.

All Splits (Children's 12.5 through Women's 12) \$89.95



This is the Director's Cut model. If you need a split sole but are a dancer with wide feet or a dancer that needs larger than a Women's 12 / Men's 10 but still need to do toe work, this is the shoe you'll want. Shoes have a double-reinforced toe box and a soft leather upper. Shoes run true to size and are available in narrow, medium, and wide widths. Order **White** with **Buck Taps** installed.

Children's size 13.5 to 3	\$89.95
Women's size 5 to 12	\$89.95
Men's size 5 to 15	\$90.45

NOTE: Split sole shoes are optional in intermediate classes and highly recommended for students in advanced classes and/or on the Exhibition and Competition teams.
