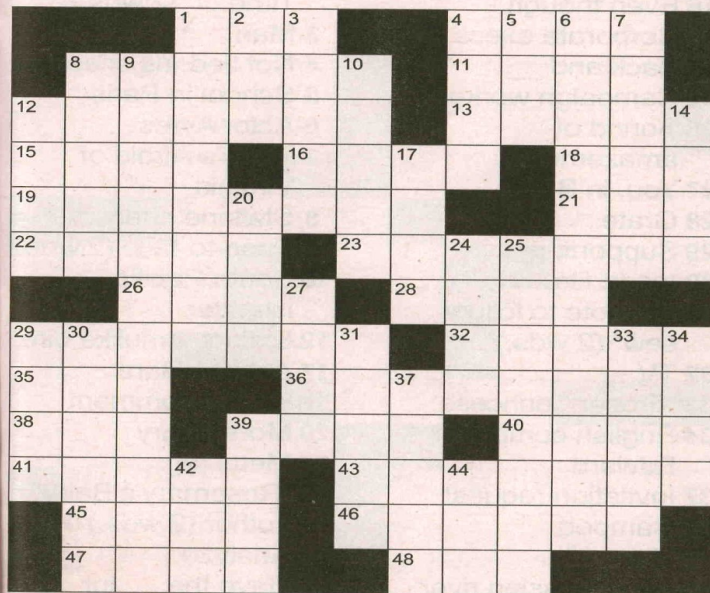

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Meet the 2026 MRA Rodeo Royalty Candidates



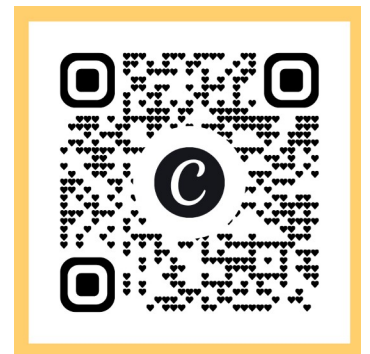

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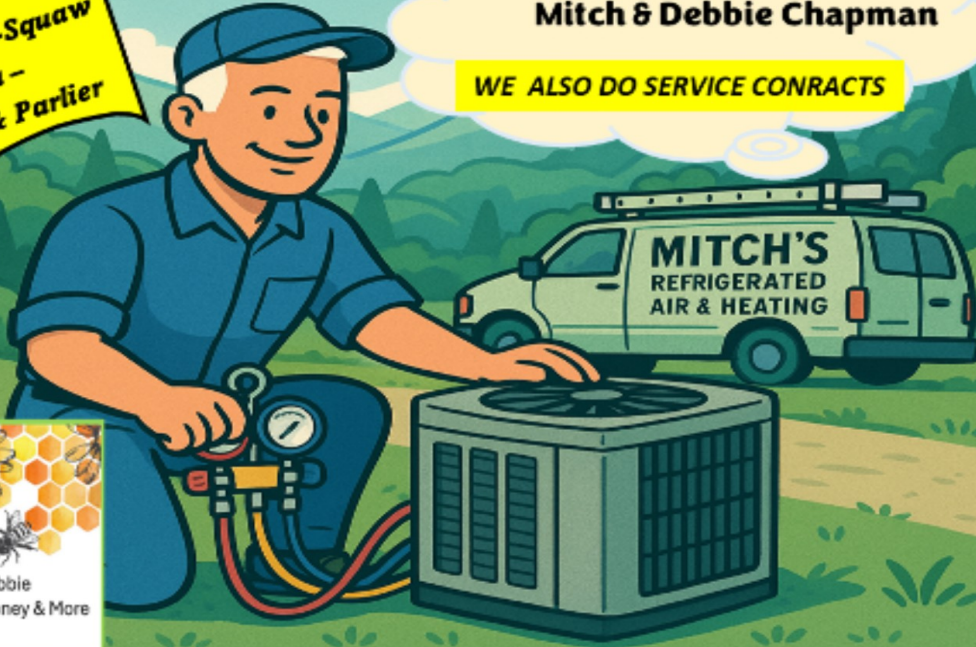
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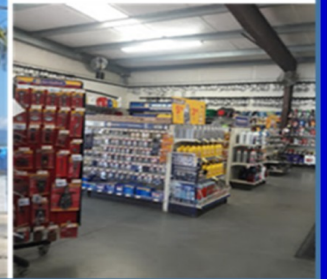

in fear. She grabs her son again by his wrist and pulls him up,

opens the doors between cars (ignoring the warning signs)
and drags her son into the next of an endless stream of struggle.

Buck Rock: A Hidden Gem in Kings Canyon National Park



Perched high above the Sierra Nevada, Buck Rock is one of the most spectacular viewpoints in the Kings Canyon area. Located along a winding mountain road near Hume Lake, this historic granite dome is home to the Buck Rock Fire Lookout, which has been watching over the surrounding forests since the 1920s.

We decided to take our friend—and ourselves—on a little adventure. The hike to the top is short but steep, requiring visitors to climb a narrow stone staircase carved into the granite. Every step is worth the effort. At the summit, we were rewarded with breathtaking 360-degree views of the Sierra National Forest, Kings Canyon National Park, and rugged mountain peaks stretching as far as the eye can see. On a clear day, the scenery is simply unforgettable.



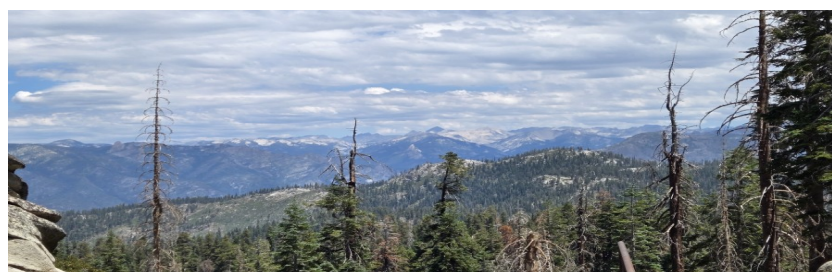
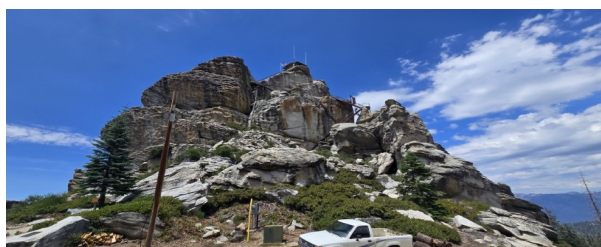
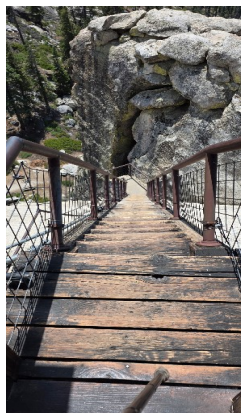
During the summer months, volunteer fire lookouts welcome visitors and share the fascinating history of the lookout, along with stories about wildfire detection and forest conservation. We had the pleasure of meeting Michigan, a volunteer with the Buck Rock Foundation, who explained that volunteers spend four-day shifts at the lookout, keeping watch for signs of wildfire. She also shared the rich history of the tower and the important role it continues to play today.

I have to admit, I had to overcome my fear of heights to make the climb, but it was absolutely worth it. The incredible views made every nervous step worthwhile.

After making our way back down, we met Mr. and Mrs. Saunders, also members of the Buck Rock Foundation. They were full of interesting information about the lookout, offered Buck Rock souvenir T-shirts, and even presented Sal with a certificate recognizing his accomplishment of reaching the top!

We also met Kristie and Cindy from Sanger, who proudly told us that their 83-year-old mother had made the climb to the summit. Hearing her story was truly inspiring and a reminder that determination can take you to amazing places.

Whether you're an avid photographer, a hiking enthusiast, or simply looking for an unforgettable scenic stop, Buck Rock offers one of the most memorable panoramic views in California's Sierra Nevada. If you're visiting Kings Canyon or Hume Lake, this hidden gem deserves a spot on your itinerary.

August Skies Offer a Spectacular Show Above Squaw Valley

August is one of the best months of the year to enjoy the night sky, and residents of Squaw Valley are fortunate to have some of the darkest viewing conditions in the region.

The month's highlight is the annual Perseid Meteor Shower, expected to peak on the nights of August 12 and 13. Under clear skies, viewers may see dozens of meteors each hour after midnight. No telescope is needed—just find a dark location, allow your eyes to adjust, and look toward the northeastern sky.

August is also an excellent time to view the Milky Way arching across the sky. Away from city lights, its bright star clouds and dark dust lanes create a breathtaking sight. Binoculars can reveal even more hidden treasures among the stars.

Saturn and Jupiter will also be on display this month. Saturn's famous rings are becoming easier to see through a small telescope, while brilliant Jupiter rises before dawn in the eastern sky.

Whether you're an experienced stargazer or simply looking for a peaceful summer evening outdoors, August offers a wonderful opportunity to enjoy the beauty of our foothill skies. Grab a lawn chair, bring the family, and look up—you never know what you might see.

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CREATE A WILDFIRE ACTION PLAN

Your Wildfire Action Plan must be prepared and familiar to all members of your household well in advance of a wildfire. Use the checklist below to help create your plan. Each family's plan will be different, depending on a variety of issues, needs, and situations.

CREATE AN EVACUATION PLAN THAT INCLUDES:

- A designated emergency meeting location outside the fire or hazard area. This is critical to determine who has safely evacuated from the affected area.
- Identification of several different escape routes from your home and community. Practice these routes often so everyone in your family is familiar with them in case of emergency.
- An evacuation plan for pets and large animals such as horses and other livestock.
- A Family Communication Plan that designates an out-of-area friend or relative as a single point of contact among family members in case of separation.

BE PREPARED

- Have fire extinguishers on hand and make sure everyone in the family knows how to use them. Many have expiration dates — check yours.
- Ensure you and your family know where the home's gas, electric, and water main shut-off controls are located and how to safely shut them down in an emergency.
- Assemble an Emergency Supply Kit for each person, as recommended by the American Red Cross.
- Maintain a list of emergency contact numbers in your cell phone, home phone, and Emergency Supply Kit.
- Keep an extra Emergency Supply Kit in your car in case you cannot get to your home.
- Have a portable radio or scanner, or follow the Ready for Wildfire App. Visit incidents.ReadyforWildfire.org

- Important documents (birth certificates, passports, insurance)
- Pet food, water & medications
- Can opener

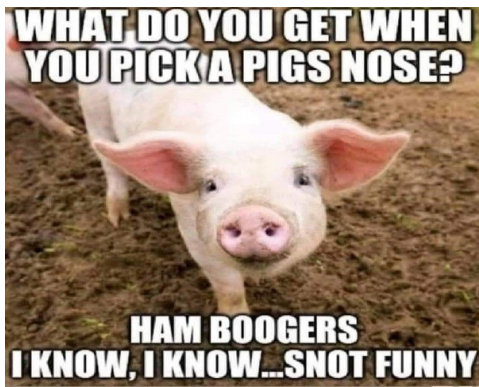

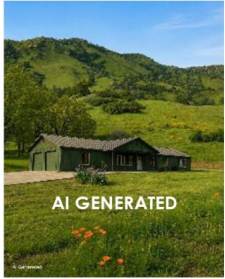
