

From the Minister's desk....

Recognizing Your Resources



2 Corinthians 9:5-8

People who are unable to recognize their resources and can't make them work for them are finding themselves falling farther behind in this race we call life. One of the greatest liabilities of many of America's youth and even some adults is the failure to realize that we must put out or invest in something, to take in or get something back.

According to our text the apostle Paul had embarked upon a fund-raising campaign, he looks externally on the behalf of those in Jerusalem, and he solicits the resources of others and in this case the Corinthians. In his approach to them, he compares benevolence and charity with Agriculture; as "a farmer sowing and reaping." He puts out to take in...

Today we want to encourage our youth to recognize, access and appreciate the resources made available to them. Funk and Wagner dictionary says resources means that which is resorted to for aid or support, available means or a new or reserved source of supply, (i.e. money, product, service, or energy).

2 Cor. 8:9-14 suggests that there are moments when we fall behind financially and we resort to person number one, and person number one may have to resort to person number two or three on our behalf, and as they come through, they become our resource(s). So, our resources may be direct or indirect or both. Now I know we can all identify with that.

As Christians we have both spiritual and non-spiritual resources: Non – spiritual resources. Educational – we must be able to read, write and speak properly in order that one day we desire to teach or preach the Bible.... inmate who could not read...reduced his sentence (2) years. Life Management Skills—are needed to apply for jobs, handle complex problems, manage money and home. Social Skills—we must learn to properly communicate our feelings and expressions with others, to get along in life.

Every Christian, upon examining their own circumstance, must give according to their heart; which is to say, in line with one's heart. The heart must not only move the hand forward, but also determine how much is in the hand....so let him give bountifully, deliberately, cheerfully of his or her resources, **2Cor. 9:7.**

Conclusion: While in your youth, your life is in our hands. If you are at a point in your life and you don't know what to do with your life, have you considered Jesus and the difference he can make in your life as the ultimate resource? **John 14:6** - I am the way, the truth, and the life.


