#### From the Minister's desk.....

#### "The Virtue Of Wisdom"



As a child I remember that I always enjoyed being in the midst of older folk to listen to them talk. It seemed as if they knew what they were talking about and I needed to observe, listen, and obey to whatever they said. I thought they were really smart. However, as I grew up I realized that many of the older people such as grandparents and other senior citizens did not have a college education. As a matter of fact, some did not finish high school. I wondered how were they so smart? As I went to high school, I realized that there was a difference between having a formal education and being wise. There were many senior citizens in my life that had a lot of wisdom to share with others and they did so in an unselfish manner. How blessed I was to be in the midst of such people.

As I look at our society today, it seems as though wisdom and especially "godly wisdom" is a forgotten art. Unfortunately, this essential ingredient of "healthy living" is missing in our society as a whole. If you disagree, turn on the TV at any given time and listen to the negativity and heinous acts that are committed on a daily basis, and without remorse. We are in dire need of wise leaders to stand up and restore the integrity and moral fabric of our society.

Notice the words of Solomon, "To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding; To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity...", Proverbs 1:2,3. The opposite of this essential ingredient is disaster. Note the following, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction", Proverbs 1:7. Look at the wisdom Solomon is sharing (1) obey your parents, verses 8,9 (2) avoid bad company, verses 10-19 and (3) seek after wisdom, verses 20-33. If every home in our society would take a few minutes each day and share these verses in a family setting (primarily in the morning as they begin their day), what a drastic improvement we would experience in our society.

Solomon emphasizes that wisdom is available to all who desire to have it, "Wisdom crieth without; she uttereth her voice in the streets..", Proverbs 1:20. Since wisdom is available, why do we not act on it? Solomon answers that question when he wrote, "Because I have called, and YE REFUSED; I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded", verse 24. Again, the problem "is not" lack of spiritual wisdom in the lives of godly people. The problem is that some people in our society "don't want it". Solomon gives the consequences of rejecting this godly wisdom in verses 25-33.

Therefore, as New Testament Christians, it is left up to us to reach out to our brothers and sisters, as well as our fellow man and impart godly wisdom to let all men know that "the way of the cross leads home". Remember, let us always be Christ centered and heaven focused.
