

From the Minister's desk....



"The Virtue Of Wisdom, Part 2"

As previously stated, it is left up to Christians to take the lead in reaching out to our brothers and sisters, as well as our fellow man, to share the love of God and godly wisdom. In other words, it is not even wise to leave this responsibility up to non-Christians. The virtue of wisdom is "godly oriented", and can only be shared by ambassadors of God, 2 Cor.5:20.

Paul outlines some principles of wisdom when he wrote, "Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; And did all eat the same spiritual meat; And did all drink the same spiritual drink; for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them; and that Rock was Christ", 1 Cor.10:1-4. One can readily see that true wisdom is found in obedience to God. However, some of the Israelites fell by the wayside, "But with many of them God was not well pleased; for they were overthrown in the wilderness", verse 5.

Paul then tells us how to use wisdom in "not following" their bad example, "Now these things were our examples, to the intent we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted", verses 6-10. Paul continues to stress the importance of "not making the same mistakes" as they did when he wrote, "Now all these things happened unto them for examples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come. Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall", verses 11,12.

The virtue of wisdom entails "learning from the mistakes of others" rather than your own. We can readily see the travesty of others in our society who have suffered severely because of unwise decisions they have made in their lives. Do you think that it is "wise" to observe these situations and to follow in the same path in your life? I doubt it. That means it is "our" responsibility as Christians to be "models of godly wisdom" to a perishing world, because if "we" don't do it, who will? Remember, our Heavenly Father has never told the "world" to be a beacon of light in order to share this "godly wisdom". Every Christian should be able to say, "If it is to be, it is up to me".
