From the Minister's desk.....

"How Dads Hurt Kids Without Knowing...Fix It"

I ran across an article with the above title a few months ago. After I read it, I realized that more people are in tune to the fact that fathers play a vital and essential role in the growth of their children. No home is complete without this essential ingredient. Therefore, I decided to include the article in this week's bulletin. As you can see from the above title, it is very thought provoking.

The article is as follows:

Kids need their dads, love, attention and direction. As the following points substantiate the fact that fathers make a lasting impression on their kids. What they do, and do not do, will stay with them for years to come. Such a role must be taken very seriously and given the utmost attention.

Fathers who want to positively impact their children should avoid the following:

- 1. Communicating inconsistently
- 2. Withholding encouraging words
- 3. Showing inadequate appropriate affection
- 4. Avoiding leadership and discipline
- 5. Ignoring the choices of friends and entertainment
- 6. Modeling bad behaviors and attitudes
- 7. Regarding internet temptation? The most significant weapon we have against internet temptation is open and honest conversation

Take action to understand what is at risk here...Protect your kids. The many online dangers are as follows:

- 1. Show interest in your children's lives
- 2. Initiate conversations on the tough topics
- 3. Model how you would like your kids to act
- 4. Answer the dreaded question, "Why?
- 5. Provide structure and discipline
- 6. Remember what it's like to be their age

Most importantly, start protecting your family TODAY from harmful content online. You can join the almost 250,000 people who know that "accountability" is an effective path to online purity. In the digital age, passive parenting is not an option. Parents who are observant, engaged, and informed often have kids who learn to use technology well. Will you be one of those dads? We want to help you to not hurt your kids.

As you can see, the above article shares some of the responsibilities of the role of fathers in the home and emphasizes the need for the fathers to be "active" rather than passive in the nurturing of their children. It "is not" left up to the mothers to take the lead in initiating this effort. And, in order for all fathers to be on point regarding this matter, it is "essential" that the father is a dedicated Christian, who is following the words of the apostle Paul when he wrote, "And ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord", Eph.6:4. That beloved, is what our Heavenly Father would like all fathers to do. If all fathers would teach their children to be God focused certainly their children will be "heaven bound" Col.3:1,2.
