Fathers Matters

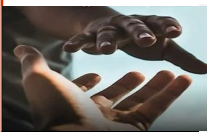
Ephesians 6:1-4

When we talk about fathers matters, a person might wonder whether we have reference to the importance of fathers, or do we have reference to issues pertaining to Fathers. It very well may mean both, because both the importance of a father and father issues are inter-related

- He is to be an example in the home: He is to be the kind of man his wife will reverence (Ephesians 5:23, 33).
- He is to be the kind of man his son(s) would aspire to become and the kind of man his daughter(s) would look for to marry. Fathers give the first impression of manhood; thus, the right kind of father must first be the right kind of man. (1 Tim. 3:5)
- He is to take interest his home and children by spending time with them: training, loving, disciplining, and teaching them life skills (Ephesians 6:4; Hebrews 12:6-11).
- It is also the responsibility of the man to provide financially for his home (1 Timothy 5:8).

As the scripture says, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do: fathers are to be forgiving. This is my beloved son, in whom I am well pleased hear ye him: fathers are to commend and praise their children."
