## **Funding Requests**

- Mrs. Staley class field trip: Mrs. Staley requested \$50 to take her kinders on a field trip to The Scoop. The executive board already approved this request.
- Tennis: Corey Newman submitted a request for \$400 to fund Tennis as an extracurricular activity. Jeff Klein motions to approve. Kelly Olson seconds. All in favor.
- Conference Funding: Amy Barker requests approximately \$275 to cover remaining expenses to attend
  an educational technology conference. She already has grant funding to cover the majority of the trip.
  Dave Gilbert motions we approve up to \$300. Lara Nybo seconds. All in favor.
- House System: Alexis Padgham requests \$4,700 to fund house tshirts for a new house system that Wilson will implement. The program aims to improve building community across grade levels, increase attendance & decrease discipline issues in common areas. 4 Houses, 1 Wildcat family.
