Master Building Committee – Josie Dix

They think the gym will be an extra \$4M – the District has \$1M – we still need \$3M. (TBD if donors could have any naming rights). The demo for the planned 2019-2020 project starts in June, but the District has said they could demo the gym as late as January 2020, if we get funding in time for plans by then. They are already scaling up mock-ups.
