Call to Order – 7:08 p.m., Josie Dix

May Minutes – Alex. Evans

- Laura Cook-Crotty moved to approve May minutes. Alex. Evans 2nd. Vote: ALL in favor.

Treasurers Report – Zack Kozel

- Writing checks to teachers for approved funds
- Many thank you notes have come in from teachers
- Ms. Bresson update: \$1500 will be great for a new Gaga Pit – will start next fall and give lessons. Also ordered an equipment cart w/ jump rope stand. Bins for each classroom w/ balls – will encourage responsibility and accountability for equipment. Will be taking over as playground equipment manager next year. Will continue to price out new things for playground.
- Alumni scholarship application – currently at \$500 for one recipient – updated this year to give one recipient \$500 and two additional recipients \$250 each (\$1000 total).
- Mrs. Padgham request for fund for 2019 spring drama production - \$1100. Discussion:
 - o This is a great program, worthy of funding
 - o Should maybe charge or ask for donation at the performance to supplement
 - o Feels like a lot of money for just 25 kids to be involved
 - o Missoula Children’s Theater option: 50-60 students, K-6, \$3000, could be done in addition to Mrs. Padgham – 2 productions/year
 - o Maybe ask Cataldo if we could join forces
 - o Another idea would be a talent show – could involve more kids, but we need a parent to run this
 - o Should speak to her before telling her how to run her program
 - o ****Look for a parent who would be interested in taking on a talent show****
 - o We have the money this year
 - o Letterman jackets – not necessarily part of PTG responsibility, but hard to cut off
 - o There are kids who didn’t make it in the 25 student cut-off
 - o Josie motion to give \$1000 to drama program. Makisha 2nds. ALL in favor.
- Popsicles at end of Field Day – request for funds to purchase from Mrs. Bresson – request approved
- Mrs. Coyote request for new laminator machine. This is not part of what the district pays for. The current one works...sometimes. A new one is \$3000. This is a lot of money. Josie will call the district and confirm. We are going to see what else we can do before approving funds for this.

- Missoula Children's Theater – will revisit this next Sept.
- Connection with Cataldo for drama – will revisit next Sept.
