# - Transportation plan

- Busing is encouraged! That area is very congested.
- $\circ$  Yellow sheet passed out with routes coming home with students tomorrow
- o Bus is most safe and efficient way to be transported
- Bus stops have already been determined
- Can change which bus you want if need be just give SPS transportation a call
- o Adjustments may be made in Sept
- Going from 3 buses currently to 6 buses
- Bus class for students each class at Wilson will be taken through "bus class" before the end of the school year – going over etiquette, safety, etc.
- Buses stay at each stop for 1-2 min (no longer!) then move on be on time!
- PRACTICE RUN! Wednesday, Aug 28<sup>th</sup>, (day before school) pick-ups at stops on time, parents welcome to join, will tour building for 1 hour while at Camp Wilson, then will load the buses and practice drop-off.
- Routes will be assigned and communicated from the district via email and text in August
- There is a bus tracker app Durham Bus Tracker need student ID number will give real time info and updates
- No effect on Express there will still be usual buses from/to Roosevelt for Express before/after school
- o There will be crossing guards at the intersection at 37<sup>th</sup> and Grand
- Z passes barcoded pass unique to each student student swipes on/off bus, text is sent to parent to alert their child has gotten on/off bus – get them at school – not mandatory, but a great tool

- Form online to designate different pick-up and drop-off locations, otherwise not allowed to get off at a stop other than the designated stop
- Please make sure your child knows how they are getting home each day
- Building Update
  - o Garco takes over property the day after school gets out
  - Should be done next August (2020) for move back in
  - Teachers should have classrooms packed up the day after school is out

  - Tearing down existing addition, adding 8 classrooms, tearing down existing gym/kitchen and building new
