- After school running and self-esteem program for girl. Coaches are adult female mentors. Pair girls based on pace. Run and talk about life. Healthy habits, bullying, standing up for yourself. Do YPQ training.
- Has been at Wilson since 2015
- Official Dist 81 program not allowed to charge for program
- At 16 Dist 81 schools with 393 girls
- Dist gives \$15/girl
- Asking for support for Wilson team and another school's team for next season
- Money goes to salary, curriculum, t-shirt, medal, snacks ... 1. Celebration 5k, 2. Running gear for those in need, 3. Curriculum
- Asking for \$4,725 for supporting two school
- Have grown 74% in past years
- Not allowed to turn girls away
- Without funding would need to turn girls away or cut programming at certain schools
- Katie: Parents did not know that they could pay for their kids
- We will table a decision on this until next month
