Words their Way is a research based developmental approach to phonics, spelling and vocabulary. It allows educators to tailor instruction to a student's specific developmental level. Based on the initial assessment an educator can plan for intervention using the different activities, games, or other tasks the book provides. This helps students build on their phonics skills. The desired outcome is growth in reading and writing-the student learns about patterns to words and build upon their vocabulary.
