Treasurer's Update, Ana Ehrler, Treasurer -4 min

- **Budget Update—**
 - Raised \$1900 from Dine Out Events
 - Carnival made more than expected and spent less than expected
- **2026-27 Budget Proposal**
 - Differences from this year to next year include:
 - Scholarship committee requested increase from \$1500 to \$2000
 - Increasing field trips to \$4500
 - Increasing teacher checks by \$100 to \$400
 - One Book, One School request entered into the budget
 - Plan to leave \$15,000 in account to get us through to the 2028 Wildcat Walk
 - Still leaves about \$8000 in discretionary funds going into next year
 - Kendra moves to approve next year's budget. Kelli seconds. Motion passed unanimously.

Information Items

- **Principal's Update**—Mike Syron (7 min)
 - School Improvement Goals:
 - MAP testing goal of 70% pass rate for Wilson
 - Fall/Winter scores were 73% for ELA and 70% for Math
 - Extracurricular Goal for 80% of students to be involved
 - 43% of free and reduced lunch students participated and 76.19% overall participation
 - Climate Survey:
 - Spring Assessment on climate fell right during SBAC testing this year
 - 4.2/5 for the year
 - School district no longer calls individual paras “one on ones” but “building paras”
 - Wilson will not have MTSS next year; will supplement with building paras instead. Due to district-wide reduction.
 - Kristen Griffith will be the new half-time resource teacher
 - Janae Passinetti is moving from 1st grade to kindergarten; Deanna Bunch will teach 3rd grade; new to Wilson Kathy Chalich will teach 1st grade and Lee Hancock will teach 2nd grade
 - Need 5 more kindergartners to allow for 3 kindergarten classrooms.
- **DEI Committee Update**—Raederle Swanson (3 min)
 - Supporting the teacher Community Connections group with the PTG funds, resources, and time
 - Meetings start in September and fall every other month
 - Goal is to increase numbers
 - Looking forward to a Multicultural Night in conjunction with LC Feeder Pattern program (looking for someone chair the event)
 - One Book/One School program
 - Have provided diversity books for the library for all classrooms to access
 - Kendra shares about the 5th grade field trip down to FEAST World Kitchen thanks to PTG/DEI funding
- **Green Club**—Bre Orcasitas (4 min)
 - Last event was a walk up to Comstock to explore camping equipment
 - Practiced setting up tents
 - Learned about reading maps and compasses
 - Not currently a Green Club leader for next year
