Wyoming Family Resource Centers

Wyoming communities have lacked a coordinated human services system. Siloed services, agency duplication, and gaps in data sharing create barriers for Wyoming residents.

Family Resource Centers address these barriers, providing on-site health and wellness programs, services, resources and referrals, activities, and classes that strengthen Wyoming families, individuals, and communities all in one place, so those seeking help only need to make one trip to solve several problems, rather than many trips to different locations.

At any Family Resource Center in Wyoming, you will find:

Access to essential services, resources, and information

Help with things like parenting advice, child care referrals and resources, counseling, and job training

Home visiting, parent education and enrichment programs, concrete support assistance

Youth and child development programs

Each Family Resource Center is adjusted to the needs of its community. Every town and every city is different, so every Family Resource Center works closely with their community to meet their needs.

To establish Family Resource Centers or strengthen existing Centers across the state, grants are being awarded to Wyoming communities.

A collaborative statewide network, the Wyoming Family Resource Centers Collective, has been formed to provide grantees with technical assistance and best practices for establishing the Family Resource Center in their community.

Family Resource Centers are more than just buildings — they are hope and support for Wyomingites experiencing life's challenges.
