2026 Greater Baltimore USBC Youth/Adult Tournament Rules

Please read all rules. Failure to read is no excuse!

1. The GBUSBCA Youth/Adult Tournament is open to all youth bowlers who are currently certified in either a Greater Baltimore or a Nation's Capital Area Youth League. Adults may be from any association as long as they are currently USBC certified. All USBC Youth Tournament rules and regulations will apply.
2. Initial entry closing date is Friday, November 1, 2026 at Midnight. Entry fee will be \$60 per team, per squad. No entry will be accepted without full fees and completely filled out entry form. No entry fee will be returned after the closing date. Any returned check is subject to a \$35 fee. Entries received after the closing date will be accepted based on lane availability.
3. Doubles teams must consist of one (1) Youth Bowler and one (1) Adult Bowler. Male, female and mixed doubles teams are allowed.
4. Multiple entries will be allowed based on availability. Bowlers may place only once with the same partner and may place both times with different partners.
5. All doubles teams will be competing in the same division.
6. Handicap is 100% of the difference between the doubles team average and 460.
7. No participant shall be allowed to use any tobacco products, drink alcoholic beverages or use foul language or gestures. Bowlers must remain within their assigned lanes during competition.
8. Attire: No hats, short cutoffs, bare midriffs or clothing with rips, tears, holes or suggestive or inappropriate language will be allowed. Tournament officials have the right to require bowler to change to appropriate attire before allowing them to participate in any event. **No electronic devices including (iPods, headphones, cell phones, video games, etc.) will be allowed in the bowlers' area. This rule includes all participants.**
9. All entrants shall use their highest 2025-2026 winter Bowl.com average based on a minimum of 21 games. Summer averages of 21 games or more will be accepted if the bowler does not have an eligible winter average. If a bowler doesn't have a 2025-2026 average, then we will accept their highest current season average as of November 1, 2026 based on a minimum of 21 games (A League Standing Sheet **MUST** be provided for verification purposes). If none of the following applies an average of 230 will be used. **If bowlers have a Challenge/Sport Average, the average will be converted to the standard average based on current USBC rule book. If the converted average is higher than the standard average, the converted average will be used. Tournament Director has the right to correct any mistake in age, average, handicap or tournament score. Falsification of average will result in disqualification.**
10. USBC rule 319 A-3 will be waived with Tournament Director adjusting averages to reflect the correct average as required to ensure no one is disqualified under this rule.
11. All bowlers must check in 30 minutes prior to schedule squad time **and present current USBC sanction card**. Late bowlers shall receive 0 for all missed frames. Substitutes will be allowed and must take the original place of the original bowler.
12. Awards/Scholarships will be awarded at a ratio of at least 1:6. Scholarships will be awarded to only youth bowlers. In the event of a tie for any place, the scholarship will be evenly divided. The Tournament Committee will make the final decision regarding the distribution of all scholarship monies. All scholarship monies will be deposited into the GBUSBCA SMART Account Number 9397.
13. Any rules not covered will fall under the current USBC Playing and Tournament Rules. Any protest/appeals must be made in writing within 72 Hours to the Tournament Director. Any protest regarding scoring must be made in writing to the Tournament Director within 24 hours after the error has occurred.
