

3. There are absolutely NO discharging of weapons allowed within the park areas, this includes air rifles/guns, bows and arrows, BB guns, paintball weapons, etc. There are also no fireworks allowed within the park areas. Any violation of these rules will be immediately reported to the Comal County Sheriff's Department and subject to a fine of up to \$1,000 and/or loss of park privileges as determined by the Board.
4. UTV/side-by-side vehicles (including golf carts) are allowed within park boundaries with access on designated trail areas only. Speed limit 5 MPH for all vehicles. Licensed vehicles must be kept on the paved roads only and adjacent designated parking areas. Violators of this rule will be subject to a fine in the amount up to but not to exceed \$500, plus any/all expenses incurred by RPOA to repair damages, if applicable, and/or loss of all park privileges for 6 months. Additionally, State Statute 90.002 states that the operation of a motor vehicle in or on a protected fresh water area (the bed, bottom, and banks up to the gradient boundary) is prohibited and subject to a fine of \$500 by the State of Texas, separate from the RPOA fine.
5. Park gates must be kept closed and locked at all times; there will be no exceptions.
6. Animals are not allowed within the enclosed pool area. At all three (3) parks, animals must be kept on a leash at all times. Animals that are allowed to run loose will be reported to the Comal County Animal Control department. Please clean up after your pet. Violators of this rule will be subject to a fine in the amount up to but not to exceed \$500.00.
7. Glass and Styrofoam containers are not permitted within the park areas; there are no exceptions to this rule. Violators of this rule will be subject to a fine in the amount up to but not to exceed \$500. State Statute 324.001 allows for a fine of up to \$500.00.

The following rules apply to the POOL PARKS only:

8. No food or glass inside the pool area. Violators of this rule will be subject to a fine in the amount up to but not to exceed \$500 and any/all cost of damages.
9. Swimming at the pool is at your own risk; there is no lifeguard on duty and RPOA will not assume responsibility for accidents, injury or theft. Children under the age of twelve (12) are not allowed within the pool enclosure without direct adult supervision. Violators of this rule will be subject to a loss of park privileges for a period up to but not to exceed 3 months and/or a fine up to \$500.
