Here's what you need to know for your upcoming tour:

For the safety of our preschoolers, all doors remain locked. Please ring the doorbell when you arrive, which is found just off the 1st parking lot on your left as you turn onto Forest Drive from Barnett Shoals Rd. The doorbell is to the right of the double glass doors under the awning.

*If you are coming on a **Friday**, please come to the preschool glass doors, as the church office is closed.



Where to park M-TH: Park in the very 1st parking lot to your left once you turn onto Forest Rd. from Barnett Shoals Rd. This is a small one-way, U-shaped parking lot. (The entrance to the U is the 2nd driveway.) It is marked on the map in **GREEN**. Ignore the Handicap signs, as they are not enforced during non-church hours. When you arrive, you will be entering the main office side of our church campus, where Teresa (church secretary or Kasey preschool director) will meet you for your tour.

Where to park Friday: Continue on Forest Rd and turn into the big parking lot before you reach Brookwood Dr. This is marked in **BLUE** on the map. Then come to the glass preschool doors where Kasey will meet you.

Tour times: 9:30am-11:30am Monday-Friday. (Please call for an appointment.)

Tour length: 30 minutes or less.

What happens on a tour?

Kasey will walk you around to every part of our preschool, providing descriptions for each part of the building. You will be able to peek into each classroom, with the hopes of seeing all parts of a typical preschool day: circle time, center time, snack time, recess, music and movement, etc.

Since each classroom follows a unique schedule, it allows an opportunity to see each aspect of our preschool day.

Some policies and procedures will be detailed on your tour. If you more details are desired, a copy of our parent handbook may be emailed to you upon request.

Should I bring my child on a tour?

Children are welcome to come along, and this decision is up to the discretion of each family.

Please note that for safety and protection reasons, only enrolled children are permitted into the classrooms and playground during preschool hours. If your child comes to tour, he/she will need to remain in your care.

What should I bring for my tour?
