## About The Lou Stefanski Foundation

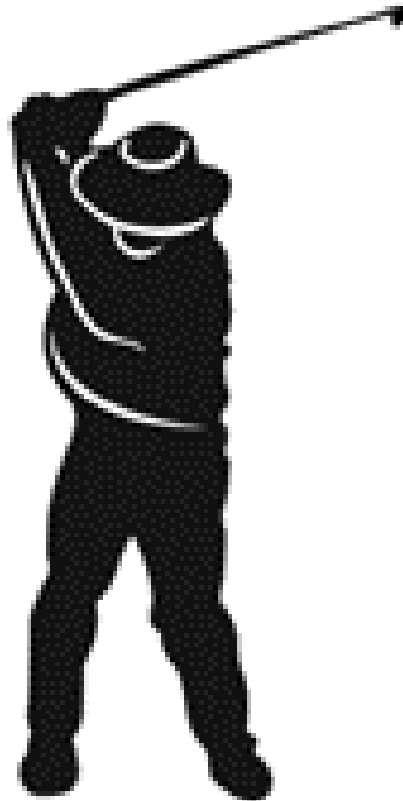

The LSF runs an annual golf tournament at Great Neck Country Club in honor of Lou Stefanski, to keep the memory of him alive. LSF then donates the proceeds of the benefit to local individuals as scholarships to further their education. The LSF's operated charity events will collect a combination of charitable contributions and donations, as well as registration fees to donate scholarships to qualified individuals for education.

Lou Stefanski was a 1979 graduate of Stonington High School.
