

## 2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION "MBC FOUNDATION SCHOLARS" AWARD

## THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Morris Brown College Foundation has been granted generous donations to establish scholarship funds that provide financial resources to be awarded to full-time undergraduate students. The value and number of scholarships available may vary according to the criteria set for the scholarship dollars.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

- 1. The online application will be available on our website (mbcfoundationinc.org).
- 2. A completed application, current school transcript (2.75 GPA is required), and 200-word essay must be returned to the scholarship committee via the *online application* on the MBCF website or emailed to *info@mbfinc.org* by 5pm on August 21, 2024. Please check with the MBC Foundation to verify that your application has been received. The application must be submitted electronically. Any questions regarding the application or requirements should be directed to info@mbcfinc.org.
- 3. After reviewing the applications, the scholarship committee will contact the selected applicants via email. The scholar will be required to provide a publicity release, a current photograph, and attend an event that will be photographed and/or recorded for scholarship award (if applicable). If an award ceremony is announced, the applicant is required to attend. If the applicant is unable to attend, then the student must contact the Executive Director prior to the awards ceremony.
- 4. The application is for one academic school year. The student may reapply in the following years, if the qualifications are met. Students may only receive *ONE* scholarship per academic school year.
- 5. Current Morris Brown College student requirements:
- 2.75 GPA
- Current Transcript
- 200-Word Essay "Which academic achievement are you most proud of and how has it prepared you for your education at Morris Brown College?"

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

- 1. Scholarships are for students enrolled in full-time undergraduate studies at Morris Brown College.
- 2. Awards are available until student earns a bachelor's degree or reaches a maximum of 120 credit hours. Scholarships not available to student who have not completed a bachelor's degree.
