Scholarship Application - 2025-2026 Academic Year*

Awardees will be notified in writing of their selection to receive a monetary award. Awardees and their sponsors will be asked to sign a scholarship pledge affirming that they meet the eligibility requirements as stated herein. **Awards will be made in the form of a check to the individual awardees' institution, or to the awardee, contingent upon verification of enrollment to an accredited institution of higher learning.** Several scholarships will be awarded. The use of scholarship monies awarded is restricted to payment of tuition, fees, books, and room and board.

Eligible individuals are children or grandchildren of active duty, reserve, or retired military (officer or enlisted) who will be enrolled as a Freshman or initial student in a full or part-time, accredited degree or vocational program during the 2025-2026 academic year. Applicants or their military sponsors must reside in the Fort Benning area or associated communities. Individuals who will be attending a service academy or who accept any other full scholarships are not eligible to receive this scholarship. Scholarships are based on scholastic merit, leadership, athletic participation and community involvement. Race, color, sex, national origin, or financial need will not influence the selection. Officer parents are required to have a paid MOAA CVC Chapter membership if their child is selected for our reward.

Applications and transcripts must be completed and postmarked no later than Mar15, 2025. Applicants are responsible for ensuring the most recent copy of their grades is included. A late or incomplete application will not be considered (See last page for checklist). A written thank you note must be received prior to receiving funds.
