INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS – Ross Tenhaeff, Samm Spears, Matt Palmer, Brittney Palmer

MINUTES

- Revised meeting minutes amended to reflect revised totals including \$1,193.41 of swim expenditures with \$9,000 for a total of \$10,193.41 for Athletic Booster Purchase Requests and revising Fundraising Purchase Requests to \$16,779.00 still equaling the prior total of all requests at \$33,645.75.
- Matt motions to approve May minutes, Ross seconds, motion approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT

- Income \$10,364.16 Expenditures \$13,323.02
- Ending balance \$126,719.40
- Brittney motions to approve Treasurer's Report, Ross seconds, motion approved.

MEMBERSHIP

- 36 memberships sold for a total of \$9,279.00
- We discussed swag items and a small spirit flag with Atascadero Greyhounds logo was decided to be the main contender depending on cost and availability.

COMMITTEE UPDATES

● **Webmaster**

Anna has handed over duties to new Webmaster, Aimee Rawlings.

● **Fundraising Committee**

- Sara Cereghino has emailed contacts to see about availability for potential 2027 Greyhound Gala date of 03/13/27 for Oyster Ridge or the Santa Margarita Ranch
- Trying to get a BBQ or other community event to introduce the athletes of fall sports and coaches. Would start with a fall sports BBQ. Will connect with the city on availability of Sunken Gardens or other public space.
- Wanting to make it a priority to fundraise specifically for 6 electric golf carts for transport around campus and events. Will need to also obtain a space to store and also charge them.

● **Greyhound Gear Committee**

Aimee Rawlings is taking over as the new committee chair. Samm will look into squadlocker as an option to have ordering open for limited items all year long. We will also ask Amy to research a vendor option that could provide on demand ordering and easy delivery.

OLD BUSINESS

- Bank Change is officially complete and money will begin moving over. Online banking is available and Heather will be added access soon.
- Coach purchase requests are still needing to be streamlined. The goal is for there to be a separate process to obtain money that has been fundraised by an individual team on a more frequent basis than the once a month meeting. Considering a once a week request that can expedite funds that are easily approved due to the sport having the money available. This will be finalized at the review of the bylaws meeting with the board of directors.
- Sports physicals had a positive response this year. A maximum of 20 kids could be seen by each doctor and the registration sold out prior to the event.

- Matt Palmer is set to do an online training with Zeffy. If it works for Ross' schedule he would also like to sit in on the web based training to understand the system better.

NEW BUSINESS

- The AHS Athletic budget has been reduced for the 2026/2027 school year. We are now working with less money. Admission prices for games will be increasing across all schools in our league. This makes the Boosters memberships an even greater savings.
- The school is looking for a new athletic trainer. The position has been listed. One of the changes is that it will be mandatory for the athletic trainer to be at all home and away football games. ● Samm would like to provide coaches with Greyhound Gear, to include assistant coaches. We discussed a welcome basket for coaches that are new to their programs and a polo and/or item relating to the sport for returning coaches. In addition we decided that a coach should receive 1-2 complimentary passes to the games they coach for spouses or other family to attend as a perk for the amount of time they're contributing to their programs.
- The Board of Directors will schedule a meeting to go over and make necessary amendments to current bylaws, create the 2026/2027 budget and confirm the calendar for the upcoming year.

- Samm Spears chaperoned one golfer to CIF in Chino Hills, filling in for Joe Davis.
