- Jackie Lorenz - income \$104,332, expenses \$81,857(Large part goes to staff), net \$22,475.
- Book Fair total sales were \$17,938.83. Pay out distribution will be \$2000 in cash and the remainder in scholastic credits to be distributed to classroom teachers and librarian. Teachers/library will be receiving \$345 in scholastic credits each. .
