

# WORDS FROM OUR PASTOR FATHER KOZAK

Praised be Jesus Christ!

I place before you a reflection from St. Jane Frances de Chantal:

To enter into the presence of God let us sometimes represent him to ourselves as filling the whole universe, thinking of him as omnipresent like the air we breathe. Again, we may look upon God as surrounding us on every side, we being in him as fish are in the sea, birds in the air. Or we may withdraw into our inward selves and then with a calm, unwavering gaze look upon the divine essence as filling our soul and our very being, even as the Father, contemplating himself in his own being, generates the divine Son from whom, with him, proceeds the Holy Spirit. We may, at other times, fix our thoughts upon Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar, and reflect, as faith teaches us, that in it our Lord in his Sacred Humanity abides and that this same Humanity is seated on the right hand of the Eternal Father. Lastly, we must ever humble ourselves and acknowledge that we are unworthy to speak to God, saying with Abraham: I will speak to my Lord whereas I am but dust and ashes.

Let us tie ourselves down to prayer and never quit it, for in this game (so to say) he is the loser who gives up his prayer. If it seems to you that you are not heard, cry out the louder; if you be driven out by one door, come in by another; if you hear the words said to the Canaanite woman (Mt 15:21-28), that you do not deserve the graces for which you ask, humbly reply that like her you do not aspire to unusual favors, but only to eat the crumbs that fall from the divine table. -Saint Jane Frances de Chantal





### The 7 Deadly Sins: Envy and the Joy of Gratitude


