

# SCOTTISH JUNIOR SCULLING HEAD 2019

## ENTRY INFORMATION, CONDITIONS OF ENTRY and EVENT FACILITIES

### 1. Date, Venue and Rules

- The event will take place at Strathclyde Country Park, Motherwell, ML1 3ED on Saturday 28th September 2019.
- The event will be held under the Rules of Racing of Scottish Rowing. Competitors and coaches are reminded that they should be familiar with the Rules of Racing.
- The event will be raced as a timed head over 1900m.
- Composite crews are not allowed.

### 2. Equipment and Safety

- Competitors are expected to provide sufficient boats to meet their racing commitments. Boats may be available to rent from Edinburgh University Rowing Club. Contact [colin.williamson@ed.ac.uk](mailto:colin.williamson@ed.ac.uk)
- Coaches and competitors should be familiar with, and comply with, the Water Safety Code and Guidelines adopted by Scottish Rowing, and the Water Safety Guidelines for Rowers at Strathclyde Park which can be downloaded from the Scottish Rowing website at [www.scottish-rowing.org.uk/index.php/takingpart/clubsafety](http://www.scottish-rowing.org.uk/index.php/takingpart/clubsafety)
- Clubs should note that it is their responsibility to ensure that all boats they use at the event comply with the safety requirements, including buoyancy and heel restraints, described in the Water Safety Code and Guidelines (see above for download details). There may be checks at the event.

- b. Entry Fees (inclusive of Scottish Rowing levy). A one-off entry fee of £15 allows racing in up to four divisions. A reduced entry fee of £7.50 is available for First Year Rowing (FYR) events only.
  - c. Entries in the FYR events must have started water based rowing after 28<sup>th</sup> September 2018.
4. **Competition Licences**
- a. All competitors must be registered with British or Scottish Rowing and hold a valid Racing Licence from either organisation. **It should be available for inspection to confirm eligibility for events entered.**
5. **How to Enter**
- a. Entries close at midnight on Wednesday 18th September 2019.
  - b. Scottish Rowing affiliated clubs MUST use the Scottish Rowing 'rowingentry.com' system.
  - c. Clubs NOT affiliated to Scottish Rowing may use BROE2.
  - d. Both entry systems cannot process the payment structure for this event so we will invoice clubs manually for entries. The invoice will contain full payment details.
  - e. Telephone and postal entries will not be accepted.
  - f. **Late entries will not be accepted and failure to pay on time will lead to entries being removed from the Draw.**
6. **The Draw**
- a. The Draw will be held at 1200 on Saturday 21st September 2019 at Glasgow Schools Rowing Club, East Boathouse, Glasgow Green, Glasgow, G40 1BA.
  - b. **Please ensure that the club official whose mobile telephone number was supplied on the entry system keeps a copy of the entries with them – and their mobile switched on – on that date, in case of queries during the draw. We may also wish to contact you in the period between entries closing and the draw if we have any issues to discuss.**
7. **Refund Policy**
- a. **Due to the low entry cost of this event no entry fees will be returned.**
8. **Facilities at the event**
- a. Toilets and changing facilities are available in the Strathclyde Park Watersports centre.
  - b. There is ample space for trailer and car parking adjacent to the Watersports Centre.
9. **Photography**
- a. The event takes place in an environment to which the general public has free access. A number of people attending the event, over whom the organisers have no control, may take photographs. Competitors, club managers and parents should bear this in mind when considering entering the event.
