ALL NHSRA MEMBERSHIP PAPERWORK MUST BE COMPLETED AND UPLOADED TO YOUR NHSRA PORTAL BEFORE THE SYSTEM WILL ALLOW YOU TO ENTER. PLEASE ALLOW UP TO 24 HOURS FOR YOUR PAPERWORK TO BE COMPLETED

You will use Equest Event to enter the rodeo. If you are a new member YOU WILL HAVE TO SET UP A NEW USER NAME AND PASSWORD on equest event. There is an instruction video on how to set it up (it is similar to the national webpage login). Please double check your entries before submitting. You will be required to pay with a card when entering. The Gate Fee is \$30.00 per family. Please make sure if you have more than one child entering (HS or JR) that you click the sibling gate fee reimbursement option on your second child's entry to avoid paying the gate fee twice.

Entries close Monday Sept 7th at midnight. Late entries will be accepted until Tuesday Sept 8th at midnight with a \$25 late fee. All fees will be taken online at the time of entry. There will be NO REFUNDS of Entry Fees after books close except for medical or vet notes pending time frame (see TNHSRA handbook).

Contestants Please bring the following forms with you to check-in: 1. W-9 2. Contestant Bio 3. Grades (if not uploaded) 4. Homeschool verification form if homeschooled and your Social Media form. All of these forms can be found on our website.

High School, Please Note that there is an option on your entry to order a felt back number (it is not mandatory and many contestants already have one, but this is the only chance to order one if you would like one).
