

Following the election on **October 16, 2021** in Statesville, North Carolina, the newly elected Board began meeting virtually, due to COVID-19, via ZOOM to organize and establish the plan to complete the yearly activities. I quickly became an active participant and representative at the Piedmont Vision Casting Retreat held at the Koury Convention Center in Greensboro, NC on October 26-28, 2021.

November continued to be filled with virtual meetings of local and connectional laity, executive officers, committees, and boards. Meetings and communications continued via ZOOM and conference call and we participated in the monthly Connectional Lay Council Prayer Call, Executive Board, Piedmont Regional Lay Council meeting, and local activities. Preparations were also made for the second WNCC Lay Council Meeting on January 22, 2022, hosted by the Charlotte District, Mr. Willie Bratcher, President. Reverend Dr. Jerret Fite, Pastor of Robinson A.M.E. Zion Church, Cheraw, SC, South Atlantic Episcopal District presented the Lay Academy. Later in the month of January, the Sensational Salisbury District and the WNCC Lay Council grieved the loss of Mr. Julius E. Suiter who developed a philanthropic revenue stream entitled "Each One Give One" which directly benefited the work at Dorothy Walls Conference and Retreat Center in Black Mountain, NC. The WNCC Lay Council was

represented at the funeral of Mr. Suiter.

During the month of **February**, Conference Lay Training took place via Microsoft Teams on February 10, 2022, with Mr. Church Williams on behalf of our International President, Mr. Joseph K. Davis. The International Ministers and Lay Association (IMLA) met via ZOOM on February 15–17, 2022. Thank God for technology – I was able to share with both! Throughout the month, we were also privileged to meet several times with the Executive Board and committees of the WNCC Lay Council.

March proved to be no exception to the fast pace of lay activities and the increased convenience of technology. Meetings via conference call, ZOOM, and Teams continued. The monthly Connectional Lay Council Prayer Call continued to be a blessing. Several meetings with committees and the Executive Board of the WNCC Lay Council were held via ZOOM throughout the month as we discussed by-laws, budget, and other concerns to improve and grow the laity. The Check-up Meeting for the WNCC was held March 26, 2022, at St. Stephens A.M.E. Zion Church in Gastonia, NC, and I was honored to present the Lay Academy. Our third WNCC Lay Council Meeting was held on March 19, 2022, with Lincolnton District and Mr. William Manning, host President. The Lay Academy was presented by Mr. Darin Kent, Chief Communications Officer of The A.M.E. Zion Church and Editor-in-Chief of The Star of Zion, Mount Vernon, NY, North Eastern Episcopal District.
