

# **BOOZE & FOOD**

Below is a list of places that if you are new to the Grande Strand you will want to check out.

### **BEER/BOOZE:**

GROCERY/BEER: There is a Food Lion Grocery 10 minutes (.3 miles) walking from the Island Vista. Walk out the front door down Sunset trail and it will be on the other side of Kings Highway.

*BOOZE:* Carolina Liquors is down 62<sup>nd</sup> Street and is 1.1 miles from the Island Vista (walk west past Food Lion behind the Circle K gas station).

## **PIZZA (Late Night):**

<u>Jimmagan's Sports Bar & Pub:</u> Open until 1am. No delivery but decent late-night food. Has pool tables & darts and decent beers on tap. Very close to Food Lion so walking distance.

<u>AJ's:</u> Open until 11. Pretty decent pizza. Delivery and a quick walk from the condos.

*Island Vista:* The pizza at the condos is actually very good. The pies are pretty decent in size. Usually stop delivering at 9pm.

#### **Restaurants:**

<u>Crave Italian Oven:</u> Within walking distance from the Island Vista. Italian bar food. Just across from the Food Lion. Don't think they take reservations so expect a wait on the weekends!

<u>Greg Norman Australian Grill</u>: Great steak house up by Barefoot Landing (15-20 min car ride). Also have outside seating on the Inter-coastal waterway. Harpo says to try the mushrooms!

<u>Ruth's Chris:</u> Very close to the Island Vista just across the intercoastal near Grande Dunes. 10 min by car.

<u>Carolina Roadhouse:</u> A must visit at least once while visiting Myrtle. They are known for the big cuts of Prime Rib and the ribs are next level. I would suggest an order of ribs as an appetizer then prime rib for dinner. Don't forget to get the house salad with house dressing. The Roadhouse is a 5 min Uber ride but they don't take reservations so expect a 45-60 min wait on the weekends. Bar seating works great here as well.

<u>New York Prime:</u> A smaller non-chain steak house. A favorite for sure as they are known for great food and even better service. Be sure to try the deserts.

<u>Island Vista:</u> Believe or not, the restaurant downstairs has a fantastic following and is usually packed by the locals. Really nice seafood options.

<u>The Library:</u> Just a couple of blocks north on Kings Hwy. Two thumbs up from Brian Fowles so it has to be good!

<u>Biminis Oyster Bar:</u> Up by Barefoot Landing. Never been but heard great things from others. Very casual fresh seafood. 10-15 minute car ride.

### **LATE NIGHT:**

Top Golf: Fifteen minute Uber from the Island Visita.

<u>The Masters:</u> About the size of Home Depot. Past couple of years has been hit or miss. Fifteen minute Uber ride.

<u>Thee DollHouse:</u> Best place in Myrtle Beach by far. Talent is Top Notch! Golf scorecard gets you in without a cover charge. About a 20 minute ride from Island Vista

# **CLUB REPAIR/REPLACEMENT**:

<u>PGA SuperStore</u>: Place is 3-4 times bigger than Golf Galaxy. Can usually do repairs while you wait David.
