Notes

This is a children's/children's teaching song, where children can play along with an instrument, sing, or do their own actions.

The song should be played three times. Firstly, both verses should be played normally. Secondly, it should be announced that the horse wants to walk *very slowly*, and the first verse is played again at slower speed (and the performer/teacher may stop all together 'whilst the horse is eating some grass'). It should then be announced that the horse wants to run and the second verse is played again more quickly, perhaps getting faster towards the end. Thirdly, both verses are then played again by the performer/teacher alone at normal speed and at the end the performer/teacher announces 'Whoa, we are home'.
