1. Preliminary

- 1.1. The Vendor - being DK & KD Karaca T/A Yatarna Pastoral Company, ABN 55 307 032 813, PIC 3SGOR096 is bound to these Terms & Conditions by offering cattle for sale.
- 1.2. For genetic material only, the Vendor may differ from the above, and whilst these Terms and Conditions will still apply, the contract of sale entered shall be with the Vendor as described in in the sale catalogue on the respective Lot(s).
- 1.3. The Bidder - any registered bidder participating in this auction agrees upon registration to be bound to the Terms & Conditions set out here.
- 1.4. The Lot – being the number of cattle as defined in the sale catalogue and/or the progeny of these, and/or any genetic material.
- 1.5. The Buyer – the highest Bidder on any respective Lot in this auction upon auction closure shall be the Buyer of the lot which shall form a binding contract of sale between the parties, being the registered highest Bidder (The Buyer) and the Vendor, and therefore;
 - 1.5.1. the Vendor agrees to sell the Lot as per the Terms & Conditions stated herein,
 - 1.5.2. the Buyer agrees to buy the Lot as per the Terms & Conditions stated herein.

2. Standard Terms of Auction

- 2.1. Sale is by online auction. To participate in the auction and register as a bidder, visit; <https://airauctioneer.com/yatarna-pastoralcompanyannual-highland-cattle-2025>.
- 2.2. All amounts are in AUD and are EXCLUDING 10% GST where applicable. Bidders are encouraged to conduct their own market research and consider their financial position before submitting an offer.
- 2.3. Any Bidder must register before making a bid and no bid shall be accepted from any unregistered Bidder.
- 2.4. If for any reason, the Vendor is not satisfied with the information provided by a registered Bidder, the Vendor may cancel any bids placed and exclude the Bidder from the auction without any notice given.
- 2.5. No Bidder may retract a bid once the bid has been acknowledged by the auctioneer, acknowledgement may be an acknowledgment in any form made by the auctioneer at the time the bid is made, including via electronic means.
- 2.6. Close of Bidding commences at 20:00 AEST 18/05/2025. If a bid is received within 10 minutes of expiry, bidding is extended by 2 minutes.
- 2.7. Upon close of auction;
 - 2.7.1. The Vendor will provide the Buyer with a tax invoice over the amount of the winning bid plus 10% GST where applicable.
 - 2.7.2. the winning Buyer of each Lot containing live cattle agrees to pay a 20% deposit of the total purchase price within 48hrs to the Vendor's appointed bank account, with the balance due on or before pick up of the animal(s).
 - 2.7.3. the Buyer of each Lot containing Embryos agrees to pay the full purchase price within 48hrs to the Vendor's appointed Bank account.
- 2.8. If the Buyer does not comply with any of these Terms & Conditions, which includes the requirements of state law, any Lots may be re-sold by public auction or private contract in whatever Lots and manner the Vendor decides. The re-sale may be with or without notice and the Buyer is responsible for any loss and expense arising out of a re-sale and is not entitled to any resulting profits. Any deposit payments made are strictly non-refundable unless otherwise stated and shall be withheld to cover any such expenses.

3. Condition of Livestock

- 3.1. • All cattle on auction are;
 - registered with the Australian Highland Cattle Society Inc. or are eligible for registration with their registration pending
 - vaccinated with Ultravac 7in1 and Pestigard
 - Grade F.I.B. (Fully Imported Bloodlines)
 - NT-821 - free
 - Females over 2 years are pregnancy tested in calf at the time of auction
 - Bulls are fertility tested by an independent contractor and proven sires
 - Embryo dams and AI sires are registered as such with the Australian Highland Cattle Society or have their registration pending
- 3.2. Any description, pedigrees or photographs of individual Lots are for illustration and guidance purposes only and should be taken as such. Inspection before bidding is highly recommended. All cattle for sale can be viewed on farm on Sunday, 11/05/2025 and/or by appointment only.
- 3.3. The Bidder acknowledges that prior to the auction, that they have inspected the Lots which they intend to purchase, in person or via other means and are satisfied with their condition
- 3.4. Where an animal within a Lot is sold as PTIC (Pregnancy Tested In Calf), the Vendor guarantees that pregnancy was positively confirmed within 30 days of this Auction. The Vendor shall not be responsible if the pregnancy does not result in the birth of a live calf.

4. Change of Ownership

- 4.1. The Buyer must provide the Vendor with a current Property Identification Number (PIC).
- 4.2. All cattle are to be picked up within 30 calendar days upon close of Auction - unless otherwise agreed upon on in writing. Pick up or delivery must be arranged and paid for by the Buyer. Failure to comply with this, shall result in agistment and/or other fees charged to the Buyer and as incurred by the Vendor and/or cancellation of this purchase agreement. The Lots may be hold by the Vendor as a Lien against any such fees.
- 4.3. Loading facilities for trucks and cattle trailers are available, strictly no horse floats or other than purpose-built livestock trailers may be used for transporting the livestock.
- 4.4. Ownership of the cattle transfers to the Buyer upon pick up or 30 days after Auction closure and full payment received, whichever occurs first. The Buyer assumes responsibility for any disease, accident, illness or injury howsoever caused or arising to the cattle from this moment on, including but not limited to during transport.
- 4.5. For Cattle that are sold as registered, the Vendor will initiate the transfer of the registration within 10 days from the settlement of the purchase amount.
- 4.6. The Buyer of any Embryo Lots is responsible to arrange and pay for shipment of Embryos from Agri-Gene Wangaratta, VIC to their desired location.
