EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Exemplifying Leadership in a Team Environment (ELITE) Leadership Academy empowers Latina high school students to lead with confidence, authenticity, and purpose. Through a week of hands-on workshops, mentorship, and career exploration at George Mason University, students strengthen their academic, professional, and personal skills needed to thrive in college and beyond.

Professionals from Google, Amazon, Salesforce, Microsoft, and other partners guided students as they identified their strengths, refined communication skills, and built their leadership presence. Pre- and post-program surveys showed strong gains across all areas of development, including public speaking, networking, storytelling, and self-advocacy. By the end of the week, over 90% of students felt more confident in their leadership abilities and career readiness.

A panel of judges evaluated each student's final Portfolio Presentation and selected the top three for scholarships. LLT awarded \$2,500 in total scholarships: \$1,000 for first place, \$750 for second, and \$500 for third.

LLT also partnered with Macy's to host a professional shopping experience for 12 students. Each student received a \$200 budget and worked with stylists to select professional attire for future academic and career opportunities, totaling a \$2,400 in-kind donation.

Since its inception, the ELITE Leadership Academy has equipped 33 young Latinas with the tools and confidence to lead with authenticity, resilience, and pride. Each year strengthens this growing network of empowered young women who advance LLT's mission and redefine what leadership looks like.









** Introduction * Our Mission, Our Story

Leadership begins with voice, and for many young Latinas, ELITE is where that voice finds strength.

This year, the ELITE Leadership Academy welcomed 23 high school students from across the DC metropolitan area for a transformative week of hands-on workshops, mentorship, and community-building — a 130% increase in participation from the previous year.

The ELITE program addressed leadership barriers while nurturing the strengths, voices, and aspirations of its participants. Through a week of interactive workshops, mentorship, and community-building, participants explored their strengths, learned to tell their stories with confidence, and developed professional tools such as LinkedIn profiles, resumes, and personal brands.

By week's end, students demonstrated measurable growth in leadership confidence, communication, and self-awareness. Nearly 74% reported increased confidence in their leadership abilities, while more than 90% showed gains in career readiness. Students also reported stronger personal confidence, enhanced presentation and networking skills, and a deeper understanding of how to tell their stories with clarity and impact.

In 2025, ELITE continued to grow in reach and impact, shaping future leaders across every session, every classroom, and every community we serve. Together, we are building not just future professionals, but future leaders: Latinas who lead with authenticity, courage, and community.

ELITE Leadership Academy 2025 Cohort




This year, 43 students applied to the ELITE Leadership Academy, and 23 were selected by a panel of three external judges based on the strength of their applications, academic records, recommendations, and community involvement.


Our 2025 cohort represented the diversity and talent of the DC metropolitan area: 16 students were from Virginia (including Arlington, Herndon, Manassas, Springfield, Falls Church, Annandale, Woodbridge, and Alexandria), five from Maryland (Brandywine, Clarksburg, Silver Spring, Kensington, and Bethesda), and two from Washington, D.C.

More than half of the participants (14 students) were first-generation college-bound. Together, these students brought a wide range of experiences, goals, and perspectives to the 2025 program.


Girls' Rising Grade Distribution




Regions Represented

A day-by-day at ELITE

Monday: Leadership & Strengths

Students discovered their unique talents through CliftonStrengths with Leadership Facilitator, Eduardo Villavicencio.



Tuesday: Personal Branding & N'etiquitte

Students gained insights from Google on professional online presence and completed an AI Tools Certification with Ernst & Young.



Students maximized their career tools by mastering LinkedIn and resume building with Salesforce. They later visualized their paths with vision boards and personal decks that highlight their goals and strengths with Microsoft.



Thursday: Personal Storytelling & Speaking

Students crafted their personal pitch and prepared to network effectively with Amazon. They also learned how to speak with confidence and power with Public Speaking Coach, Yvonne Armenta.



Students showcased their growth and skills to a panel of surprise judges. Students were judged based on Content, Organization and Speaking Skills.



Saturday: Graduation Brunch



ELITE Students and Families were celebrated at Sabores Restaurant in Arlington. LLT hosted families, showcased everyone's accomplishments, gave certificates, and announced the Top 3 and Top 12 Winners of the Portfolio Presentations. Students also won Latina Public Speaking Decks and a free consultation with Yvonne Armenta, from Latina Present!



Our Impact in Numbers: Personal Growth

How we measured growth

Participants completed pre- and post-program surveys to assess their growth across key leadership and career readiness skills. The assessments measured confidence in leadership, self-awareness, public speaking, networking, personal branding, and presentation abilities. This approach helped evaluate the program's impact on participants' professional confidence, communication skills, and preparedness for future academic and career opportunities.

Students learned how to present themselves professionally.

Scores for personal-branding knowledge rose from **5.5** to 7.7, a **41% improvement**.

Hands-on LinkedIn and résumé workshops helped students define their strengths and project confidence in academic and career settings.

Our Impact in Numbers: Personal Growth


Students learned to share their personal stories with clarity and pride.

Comfort in storytelling grew from **6.0** to **7.8**, showing a 31% increase.

Through elevator-pitch coaching and personal narrative sessions, participants learned to articulate who they are and what drives them.



ELITE helped students believe in themselves.

Students' overall self-confidence climbed from **6.7 to 7.9**, reflecting an **18% increase**.

Through reflection exercises and supportive peer circles, participants built a stronger sense of identity and personal worth.












Our Impact in Numbers: Professional Growth



Students left better prepared to pursue their career goals.

Career-readiness confidence rose from **6.1 to 8.8**—a **44% gain.**

Through résumé building, interview prep, and LinkedIn training, **students left ready to navigate professional spaces.**

Students increasingly recognized the power of networking for their future.

Understanding of networking's value rose from **6.2 to 8.4**—a **35% increase**.

Conversations with Google, Amazon, and Salesforce leaders showed how **connections can open doors**.





Our Impact in Numbers: **Professional Growth**



Students strengthened their ability to present ideas with impact.

Presentation skills improved from **6.0** to **7.6**a 27% increase.

Daily practice, peer feedback, and final showcases built professionalism that students can carry into classrooms and careers.

Students became more comfortable sharing their voices.

Average comfort with public speaking increased from **5.8** to **6.7**, a **17%** growth.

Practice sessions and the final Portfolio Showcase gave students repeated chances to speak before peers and mentors, turning anxiety into confidence.

Participants were honored for their growth and courage, surrounded by family members and mentors. Students received certificates and raffle prizes as we proudly announced the Top 3 scholarship winners and Top 12 presenters. It was a beautiful moment of comunidad, orgullo, and celebration!



Top Presenters Earn \$2,500 in Scholarships

All ELITE participants delivered a final Portfolio Presentation showcasing what they had learned and improved on throughout the week (e.g., resume/LinkedIn, Clifton Strengths, etc.) Judges from Microsoft and M&T Bank scored presentations based on **content** and speaking skills.

Recognizing the Power of Voice

Students also competed for special recognition in public speaking. The top 12 performers received Latina Public Speaking Decks and a one-on-one consultation with public speaking coach Yvonne Armenta of Latina Present!

As a First-Gen Latina in tech and communications leader, Yvonne empowers others to use their voice as a tool for confidence, advocacy, and connection. Her approach to public speaking—rooted in *cultura*, storytelling, and authenticity—reminds students that their lived experiences are their greatest strength.

This award honors students who found their voice and inspired others with clarity, confidence, and authenticity.

Macy's Shopping Experience

The top 1 winners of the Portfolio Presentations enjoyed a professional shopping experience with Macy's stylists. This experience helped students translate what they learned during the week into action, putting their best foot forward in attire designed for college interviews, internships, and professional presentations. The curated wardrobes reinforced the importance of showing up with confidence and authenticity in every setting.

Conclusion Full Circle: From Participants to Leaders

This year, seven LLT alumnae returned, not as students, but as mentors, volunteers, and role models. Among them, Valeria and Daniela served as Program Assistants, helping to guide the next generation of Latinas in leadership. Their journeys remind us that LLT's impact continues long after graduation.
