Local Team

Local team members will participate in all local event such as all parades paid gig and competitions in the surrounding areas.

Traveling Team

Traveling team members: All traveler dancers must attend all traveling dates a dance season only exception death injuries or illness all payments on traveling must be turned in 60 days prior to departure date

School all dancers must keep an average GPA in order to participate in any upcoming events all captain need to keep an C average or you will be placed on probation.

Fundraising

All dancers are encouraged to participate in fundraising. All fundraising will go towards upcoming competitions that includes hotel costs, competition fees, van/bus rentals, airfare, Airbnb fees, activity and studio events. If a dancer does not participate in the fundraisers, they are required to make full payment upon the fundraiser due date.

Code of Conduct

Social Media

No parents should be on any majorette coaches directors group's online. Any parents being caught talking bad about the company, the children, or the coaches etc will be terminated effective immediately and contract still has to be paid in full.

Competitions

During competition, all dancers, parents, and affiliates are to remain within the proximity of the team. This prevents any issues or negative interactions. Neither parents nor dancers are allowed to approach the judges, hosts, and coaches/dancers of another team.

Team Apparel

We adhere, and hold ourselves and our members to the highest ethical standards. We expect our dancers, parents, and staff members to always represent us in a positive light especially while wearing, displaying, or representing our team brand. Anyone caught misrepresenting our team brand will be terminated from the team.



Demerit System

Purpose

To help maintain discipline, promote reliability, and uphold fairness for all by setting an example of good behavior, unity, and pride.

Guidelines

Only the coach can give demerits. Captains may suggest demerits to the coach. Three offenses of the same nature constitute removal from the team. Fifteen demerits accumulated during the season constitute removal from the team. All captains will receive double demerits. If a captain receives five demerits, they will be relieved of their office. Members on dance probation, due to demerits, are still required to attend all practices and performances.

Penalties of Demerit System

5 demerits: Suspension from squad for one week and parent notification.

10 demerits: Suspension from squad for two weeks and notification to parents in writing that the dancer is in jeopardy of dismissal.

15 demerits: After administrative and coach review, there will be an automatic dismissal from the squad with written notification to parents.

Demerit System

Coach will issue demerits OR dismissal for the following: smoking, drinking alcohol, possession of illegal drugs, stealing, fighting at school or a team function. Absences that are excused and will receive no demerits include: illness with a doctor's note, death in the family, and academic responsibility (missing part of practice for a test or other approved academic reason will carry no penalty, but PRIOR approval must be obtained from the coach, or demerits will be assigned). Demerits may be worked off in three ways: 1) At the end of the quarter, for every class in which the dancer receives an A, they will receive 1 demerit credit back; 2) A service to the team, to be determined by the coach; 3) The dancer may run laps or other conditioning exercises = ½ demerit credit back. See the coach for work off days or other creative ideas that will benefit the squad.

The following infractions will result in 1 demerit per occasion:

- Any tardy less than 10 minutes (practice, performance, etc).
- Inappropriate dress (at practice, competitions, or performances)
- Failure to limit socializing at practices or performances.
- Excessive talking can result in more than one demerit per practice.
- Has to be asked more than once to put food or drink away.
- Wearing jewelry that is not approved to practice or performances.
- Failure to wear make-up at a performance.
- Wearing colored nail polish when performing.
- Is not courteous or quiet during practice or performance.
- Not participating with the team.
- Cell Phone usage without permission during practices and performances.

Demerit System

•The following infractions will result in 2 demerits per occasion:

•Any tardy beyond 10 minutes (practice, performance, etc).

•Missing practice or performance once (any reason other than excused).

•More than one occasion will result in additional demerits, at the coach's discretion.

•Leaving practice early without prior approval.

•Leaving performances early without prior approval.

•Failure to meet deadlines for turning in money, uniforms, paperwork, or other assigned projects.

•Failure to wear the assigned outfit or uniform (includes hair and make-up).

•Public displays of affection while in uniform or during functions.

•Failure to perform "full out" when asked by the coach or officer.

•Failure to bring in appropriate materials to practice (shoes, uniform, etc).

•Unnecessary scenes at practice or functions (arguing with other dancers, parents, boyfriends, etc).

•Inappropriate make-up or jewelry.

•Untidy uniform.

•Profane language.

•Disobeys a small request by the coach or captain(s).

•Any referral which requires formal disciplinary action.

Demerit System

- The following infractions will result in demerits up to 5 per occasion.
- Disrespectful behavior toward the coach or other members of the team (includes gossip).
- Disobeys a request by the coach or captain(s).
- Unexcused absences.
- A dancer choosing not to perform without coach approval.
- Lying.
- Referrals concerning repeated disciplinary action.

IF A DANCER MISSES THE PRACTICE HELD PRIOR TO A PERFORMANCE, REGARDLESS OF DEMERITS PREVIOUSLY RECEIVED, THEY NOT ELIGIBLE TO PERFORM IN THE NEXT DANCE. IF THE ABSENCE IS EXCUSED (ILLNESS OR DEATH IN THE IMMEDIATE FAMILY), THEY WILL NOT BE PENALIZED.
