The ELCO Youth Biddy Basketball committee will not tolerate any loud, abusive or disparaging language or comments directed at any referee, coach, player or spectator. All reported incidents from any source will be investigated by committee members. If inappropriate behavior is substantiated, one of the following actions will be taken based on the severity of the incident.

- 1. An immediate ban for the remainder of the current season from any ELCO Youth Biddy Basketball games or events for any direct physical confrontation or any threat of physical confrontation directed at any referee, coach, player or spectator either during or immediately after a game. THIS MEANS NO SECOND CHANCES.
- 2. A warning letter will be sent to the parent or spectator stating the confirmed incident of inappropriate behavior and advising them that any further instances of such behavior will result in no longer being able to attend any ELCO Youth Biddy Basketball games or events for the balance of the current season.
- 3. Failure by a parent or relative to abide by this policy will result in the dismissal of the child from his team. It is the responsibility of the player's parent to inform all relatives and friends of this policy.
