Policy for Inappropriate Behavior

Mission: The mission of the Myerstown Panther Cheerleading organization (MPC) is to provide a fun filled environment where children of all abilities are provided the opportunity to develop their skills and love for cheerleading. It is the policy of the Myerstown Panther Cheerleading organization to treat all officers, coaches, squad members, and spectators with respect and dignity.

The MPC will not tolerate any loud, abusive, disparaging language, or comments directed at any officer, coach, squad member, or spectator. All reported incidents from any source will be investigated by MPC officers. If inappropriate behavior is substantiated one of the following actions will be taken based on the severity of the incident:

- 1. A warning letter will be sent to the parent or spectator stating the confirmed incident of inappropriate behavior and advising the that and further instance of such behavior will result in no longer being able to attend any MPC games or events for the balance of the current season. Failure by a parent or relative to abide by this policy will result in the dismissal of the child from his or her squad for the remainder of the current season. It is the responsibility of the cheerleader's parent to inform all relatives and friends of this policy.
- 2. An immediate ban from the remainder of the current season from any MPC games or events for any direct physical confrontation or any threat of physical confrontation directed at any officer, coach, squad member, or spectator either during or immediately after a game. This means no second chance.

With the internet being a social network such as; Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, etc.; negative comments towards the organization, officers, coaches, or cheerleaders will not be tolerated.
