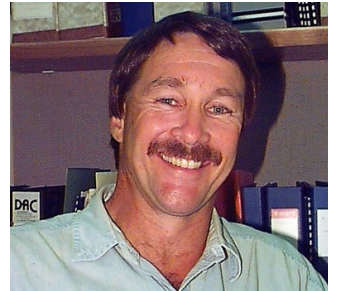


Occupational Hygiene in the Mining and Mineral Processing Industries
