Resolution Opposing the World Health Organization Pandemic Treaty and the International Health Regulation Amendments and urging that the US de-fund WHO

- WHEREAS the World Health Organization's (WHO) Pandemic Treaty and the International Health Regulation (IHR) Amendments are a threat to citizen's bodily autonomy and freedom as well as a threat to national sovereignty;
- WHEREAS the WHO wants to enact law requiring nations to censor their citizens so that only public health messages aligned with the WHO's recommendations can be shared;
- WHEREAS the new IHR Amendments would elevate WHO positions from recommendations to edicts;
- WHEREAS the treaty will apply to all nations that sign on to it all of the time, whether there is currently a pandemic or not;
- WHEREAS the proposed IHR Amendments do not define a Public Health Issue of National Concern leaving the Director-General of WHO free to declare same and begin issuing orders with limited or flawed evidence; and
- WHEREAS the IHR Amendments will be voted on at the World Health Assembly's meeting in May 2024 and countries must send a formal opt out to WHO within 10 months if the amendments are adopted by a simple majority of members present; therefore be it
- RESOLVED that the Okanogan County Republican Central Committee strongly opposes both the IHR Amendments and the WHO Pandemic Treaty and urges our elected representatives to oppose these as well; and be it further
- RESOLVED that the OCRP supports the introduction and passage of HR 79 The WHO Withdrawal Act; and be it further
- RESOLVED that the OCRP supports the introduction and passage of HR 1425 and S444 calling for No WHO Pandemic Preparedness Treaty without senate approval. All treaties must be ratified by the Senate per the US Constitution. Treaties perpetrated within groups such as the World Health Assembly and WHO must come before the Senate before becoming law. NO EXCEPTIONS; and be it further
- RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to Representative Dan Newhouse, Senators Patty Murray and Maria Cantwell, the WSRP, the RNC and posted on the OCRP website.
