United States Coinage

Half Cents

- 1 US 1803-1851 Half Cent Type Assortment, Fair-AG to VG - 15 coins. Features ten different dates with some sub-varieties, includes Draped Bust(2), Classic Head(12) and Braided Hair types. Some typical surface impairments throughout, a few with more significant marks/damage or flaws. 15 coins.

Large Cents

- 2 US 1795-1856 Large Cent Date & Type Selection, Fair-AG to Fine-VF – 77 coins. Includes forty-one different dates with some sub-varieties, features Liberty Cap, Draped Bust(7), Classic Head(8), Coronet(41) and Braided Hair(20) types. Some sporadic weak & dateless, holed or damaged pieces present while others have typical surface impairments, dark, cleaned or scratches. Unattributed by specific die varieties by Sheldon, Newcomb, Wright or Grellman. An opportunity for the specialist. 77 coins.
- 3 US 1798 Draped Bust Large Cent, Choice VF. Sharply appointed, nice brown color with some faint old underlying hairlines and a possible spot removal mentioned for accuracy. Pleasing overall presentation.
- 4 US 1800/79 & 1803 Small Date/Large Fraction Draped Bust Large Cent Pair, VG Details & AG. The first boldly detailed VG, yet porous with an old scrape obverse; the second AG and dark brown. 2 coins.

Small Cents

- 5 US 1858-LL Flying Eagle Cent, NGC XF45. Pleasing original toning and quite sharp, a nice type coin.
- 6 US 1858-1909 F.E. & Indian Cents(165) + 1893-1912 Liberty Nickels(219)AG to VG-Fine – 384 coins. Includes Flying Eagle(2), AG-G and Indian Cents in C/N – 1859(2), VG and 1863, Good as well as Bronzes, mixed dates 1880-1909(160), AG to VG-Fine, some problematic, but mostly useful collector grade/entry level pieces. Also, Liberty Nickels, mixed dates 1893 to 1912(219), includes cpl 1912-D examples, avg circ to G-VG overall, some typical weak reverses or surface impairments as usually encountered. Fun lot for the collector or as dealer stock. 384 coins.
- 7 US 1873, 1876 & 1908-S Better Date Indian Cent Trio in VF-EF, Dark/Porous VF & Fine respectively. The last example with a few old marks, yet otherwise pleasing. 3 coins.
- 8 US 1874 Indian Cent, Choice EF-AU & Lustrous. Nice lustrous brown surfaces with a trace of red in devices, looks fully AU by today's standards.
- 9 US 1877 Key Date King of the Indian Cent Series, NGC XF45BN & Select Quality. A handsome steel blue and brown toned PQ example of this highly sought after King of the series. Worthy of a strong bid!
- 10 US 1883 Indian Cent, PCGS MS65BN. Virtually mark free with a blush of brown at center of obverse and mostly Red reverse, could potentially RB on a resubmission.
- 11 US 1899 Indian Cent, NGC MS65RD. A beautiful satin Red Gem, very attractive and benefits from being a more popular 19th Century issue as well.

- 12 US 1900 Indian Cent, NGC MS65RD. A whisper of orange over strong swirling Red lustrous surfaces. Nice and very desirable.
- 13 US 1901 Indian Cent, PCGS MS65+RD. An ultra-fresh Red stunner, worthy of a CAC submission or a potential upgrade.
- 14 US 1904 Indian Cent, PCGS MS65RB. Virtually full Red obverse and just a slight tinge of brown reverse.
- 15 US 1905 Indian Cent, NGC MS64RD. Fresh Red radiant luster and nearly at the cusp of a higher grade.
- 16 US 1906 Indian Cent, NGC MS64RB. Appearance of nearly full Red and flashy luster.
- 17 US 1907 Indian Cent, PCGS MS65RD. Frosty Red luster with a tinge of pale peripheral violet color, very attractive and desirable.
- 18 US 1908-S Indian Cent, Semi-Key Date NGC MS65RD Super Red Gem. A flashy & virtually perfect glistening Red Gem, certainly at the top end of the spectrum with upgrade and/or CAC potential.
- 19 US 1908-S Indian Cent, Semi-Key PCGS VF Detail. Noted by PCGS as damaged, cpl old marks in the legend, otherwise pleasing for the designation.
- 20 US 1909-S Indian Cent – Final Key Date Issue, NGC AU55BN and PQ. Medium Chocolate Brown with luster in the devices and legends, PQ and handsome originality! A scarce grade for this final year of the series with the elusive San Francisco Mint designation.
- 21 US 1909-S VDB Key Date Lincoln Cent, ANACS AU55 Details Early Soap Bar Slab. Looks Unc. Very appealing mostly Golden-Red color and lustrous, now starting to retone while retaining full cartwheel. Noted as cleaned on the insert, yet certainly much sharper and more desirable than many examples given such nomenclature.
- 22 US 1909-2005 Lincoln Cent Collection – No Keys, Yet Otherwise Complete w/Most S-Mint Proofs in Dansco Album. No 1909-S VDB, 1909-S, 1914-D, 1922 No D, 1931-S or any overdates, yet otherwise largely complete with most S-Mint Proofs. A carefully hand assembled & quite pleasing set with a largely matching VF and better early date run - all the early D & S Mint Semi-Keys, then later date Unc Wheats and Memorials, 1959 to 2005, minus only a few sporadic issues. Housed in a deluxe Dansco album, the early coins being very well-matched and a nice set worthy of completion. 274 coins.
- 23 US 1909-2009 & Beyond Large Lincoln Cent Accumulation of Mixed Dates/Mints/Rolls & More – Approx. 1500-1700 coins. Features mostly 1909-1958 Mixed Date & Mint Wheats(approximately 500+pcs) includes a small number of Memorials in 2x2's, as well as early P & D Mint circs and many 1937 onward AU to Red Unc-BU examples. Also mixed 1961 to 1963 Unc Rolls(10), along with what appears to be a partial to nearly complete Unc Roll Set of 1982-P&D Varieties(7 variants) and a 2009-P&D T-1 to T-4 Commemorative Centennial Unc Roll Set of 8 rolls. A neat group, some rolls split/loose with counts and attributions unconfirmed and some coins intermingled. Fun lot with useful coins throughout, viewing advised. Approximately 1500-1700 coins.

Two Cents

- 24 US 1864-1871 Two Cent Piece Mixed Date Run Poor to Fair up to VG-Fine – 40 coins. Features eight different dates with duplication, five to eight dateless examples being present or with very weak dates. Approximately seven or eight pieces in pleasing VG to VG-Fine grades. Others show typical bronze surfaces and minor problems, cleanings, dark, porous or granular. Viewing advised. 40 coins.

Three Cents Silver

- 25 US 1851-1862 Three Cents Silver Mixed Date Lot Fair-AG to VG-Fine Details - 34 coins. Includes nine different dates with some duplicates, a few weak or near dateless, some typical problems - cleaned or scratched, slight bends along with a few holed or damaged, yet still a useful group. 34 coins.

Three Cents Nickel

- 26 US 1865-1881 Three Cents Nickel Mixed Date Ensemble Good/Fair to Fine Details – 40 coins. Contains eleven different dates with duplication, especially heavy duplication of the 1865 date – 19 pcs present. Some with corrosion, cleaned, dark, scratched or a combination thereof – a few damaged or pitted and a number are nicely detailed VG to Fine examples with only lt hairlines or cleanings/mild impairments. 40 coins.

Nickels

- 27 US 1866-1882 Shield Nickel Mixed Date Grouping AG to Fine-VF Details – 39 coins. Highlighted by eight different dates with areas of duplication. Some cleaned, dark, porous and with verdigris or a combination thereof. A few ltly damaged or corrosion impaired, many 1866 and 1867 issues are present. Nearly all with some degree of detriment yet useful collector dates and grades within. 39 coins.
- 28 US 1868-2006 Large Type Lot of Nickels – Shield, Liberty, Buffalo & Jefferson Avg Circ to Proof. Features Shield, 1868, corroded Fine & a dateless AG; Liberty, mixed dates 1883 to 1912, avg Circ to VG-Fine(32) and dark/culls(5); Buffalo, mixed dates 1913 to 1938-D, a nice group with full dates and pleasing grades up to EF-AU(181), partial dates(33) and dateless(59) as well as dark/culls(4) and a curved clip error partial date 1920, AG/Good. Also, a large batch of Jeffersons 1938 to 2006, avg circ to Unc/BU (approx. 450-500 pcs) including a few better grades, dates, Mints and a few later Proofs. Neat lot for the collector or for internet use. Nearly 800 coins.
- 29 US 1883 No Cents Liberty Nickel NGC MS62PQ. Handsome amber toning and nice luster with radial die cracks in both the stars and the reverse legend. Select quality for the grade.
- 30 US 1883-1912 Nearly Complete Liberty Nickel Collection Avg G-VG in Deluxe Dansco Album. A near complete collection minus the 1883WC, 1885, 1886 and 1912-S. Features duplicate 1883NC(2), F-VF and 1912-D(2), G-VG. The primary set includes an 1883NC, EF and a 1912, VF+ with most others avg G-VG, a few AG-G with weak rims. 33 coins.
- 31 US 1916 & 1931-S AU + 1938-D ANACS MS65(Color) Buffalo Nickel Trio. All with lt golden toning and nice underlying luster. 3 coins.
- 32 US 1916-1938 Buffalo Nickels Mix(206) & other Nickel/Clad Coins & More(149) Circ to Unc – 355 pcs. Includes mixed date & mint Buffalo Nickels(206), some scarcer Mint teens and twenties coins, yet many weak/partial/incomplete dates, later commons grade up to VF-EF, some surface impairments. Also, random Jefferson War Nickels(8) and others(78) dated 1938-2015; Clad Dimes(2), Statehood Qtr Set 1999-2008(42) P&D Unc in vinyl folder, hazy; Colorized Halves(7); SBA(10) & Presidential(2) Dollars, all avg Unc as well as Franklin Half, AU & 1/10oz Silver, Unc. 355 coins.

Dimes

- 33 US 1814-1836 Capped Bust Dime Ensemble, AG to VG Details – 17 coins. Contents feature twelve different dates and a few duplicates, highlighted by six earlier large size 1814 to 1827 dates issues. Some old cleanings/hairlines; cpl with lt scs, flattening or pockmarks. A useful group of entry level type coins from this scarcer series. 17 coins.

- 34 US 1838-1891 Diverse Seated Dime Collector Lot, AG to Fine-VF – 39 coins. A neat array of all different dates, Mints or type varieties. Highlighted by three different Carson City coins, a Civil War date, with and without arrows variants, O and S Mint coinage with some above and below the bow types and more. Largely full rim solid collector grades with some well-worn issues here and there. Some cleanings throughout, yet several medium gray toned pleasing collector grades as well. Nice lot with no duplication. 39 coins.
- 35 US Seated Dime Trio 1845-1886 & Other Assorted Type(21), Avg Circ to Fine – 24 coins. Features Seated Dimes, 1845, About Fine; 1850, toned VF and 1886, AG. Also, mixed date Barber Dimes(7), Standing Liberty Quarters(4) along with Liberty(2) and Buffalo(8) Nickels – Avg circ to VG-Fine. 24 coins.
- 36 US 1892-1916 Barber Dime Mixed Date & Mint Grouping, AG-Good to Fine Details – 200 coins. A wide range of dates and mints with duplication and commons throughout, most being full rims Good or better up to Fine with typical old cleanings, the usual small marks/hairlines/etc and sporadic dark, deeply toned or lightly stained examples. All housed in taped, not stapled 2x2's in binder pages. 200 coins.
- 37 US 1898 Barber Dime, NGC MS62. Beautiful original electric blue and golden-violet toning, nicely matched on both sides. Very attractive and a handsome example for a type set.
- 38 US 1912-D Barber Dime, NGC MS61. Well struck and lustrous for the numeric grade.
- 39 US 1921 Mercury Dime Key Date, PCGS VF Detail. PCGS noted as damaged, some scattered tiny digs primarily on the obverse.
- 40 US 1940, 1941-P&D, 1942, 1943, 1944-PD and 1945-PD Mercury Dime Lot, Lustrous BU – 9 coins. All nice with flashy luster and some feature FB or FSB. A fresh group. 9 coins.
- 41 US Large Mixed Date & Type Lot of Mercury & Roosevelt Silver Dimes, Avg Circ - 763 pcs. Features a broad range of common dates and mints from the Silver Mercury & Roosevelt Dime Series. Mostly average Circulated condition. 763 coins.
- 42 US 1946-1964 PDS Roosevelt Silver Dime Set, Unc & Jefferson Nickel 1938-1962 Set Circ to Unc. Nice pair of sets featured in Whitman bookshelf albums, the first set is nicely matched, mostly white lustrous Unc while the second set is VG to Unc, mostly VF or better and includes five post 1962 coins. 46 coins + 72 coins in two albums.
- 43 US 1946-2002 Near Complete Roosevelt Dime Set W/S-Mint & Silver Proofs Mostly Unc & Proof. Includes 1946 to 1964-PDS(42) missing only six random Silver examples form completion – VF to BU, largely AU-BU. Also features 1965 to 2002-PDS(118) missing only two Denver Mint common clads, otherwise complete with S-Mint Clad Proofs and nine Silver Proofs of the period(many hazy). Housed in deluxe Dansco album. 160 coins.

Quarters

- 44 US 1815 Capped Bust Quarter, Solid VG. Some faint old hairlines and a few tiny rns and marks reverse – otherwise pleasing first year example of the type.
- 45 US 1871 Seated Quarter, Cleaned EF Tiny Dig Reverse. Sharply appointed yet lightly cleaned, small dig in reverse legend.

- 46 US 1893-1916 Barber Quarter Mixed Date & Mint Lot, Avg Good to VG – 40 coins. A good mix of 24 different dates or mints plus some duplicates. Most with full rims, some cleanings or hairlines, others toned or retoning, only a few with minor impairments beyond cleaning. 40 coins.
- 47 US 1925 Standing Liberty Quarter, NGC MS64. An outstanding Gem! Clearly undergraded with a hammered, full head strike, terrific luster and originality. The look and impact of a top tier numeric grade. Worthy of resubmission and truly lovely.
- 48 US Sizable Mixed Date Lot of Washington & Standing Liberty Silver Quarters, Avg Circ - 351 pcs. Includes a wide spectrum of common dates and mints, primarily from the Washington & some Standing Liberty Series. Avg circulated condition and some dateless SLQ and early Washingtons. 351 coins.
- 49 US 1932-1964 Complete PDS Set of Silver Washington Quarters Avg Circ to Unc & Proof – 83 coins. Features the key 1932-D&S in VG and the balance of the set from avg circ to Unc & Proof on a couple of later dates. Housed in 2x2's in a small box. 83 coins.
- 50 US 1932-1998 Moderately Complete Washington Quarter Set Including the 1932-D&S in VF w/S-Mint & Silver Proofs – 169 coins. Features the Key 1932-D&S issues in VF along with 1932 to 1964-PDS(63) minus only 18 random common Silver issues – pleasing carefully collector assembled grades of VF to Unc. Also includes 1965 to 1998-PDS(103) plus duplicate Clad Proofs(3), otherwise a complete run with S-Mint Clad Proofs and seven Silver Proofs of the period(many hazy). 169 coins housed in a deluxe Dansco album.

Half Dollars

- 51 US 1812/1 Small 8 Capped Bust Half Dollar, Toned VG/Fine. Pleasing for the grade.
- 52 US 1827 Capped Bust Half Dollar, Toned EF. Handsomely toned in gunmetal hues. A nicely preserved type coin.
- 53 US 1827 & 1832 Capped Bust Half Dollar Pair, Avg Cleaned EF Details Pairing. The first with very faint graffiti and the second with some roughness and cpl old pin scs. 2 coins.
- 54 US 1832 Capped Bust Half Dollar, Choice EF Details. Some old marks and edge nicks with areas of gunmetal toning, sharp design elements.
- 55 1835 Capped Bust Half Dollar, CAC AU Details, Sharp and Lustrous. Luster remains and sharply preserved, an area of faint old hairlines obverse.
- 56 US 1854-1877 Seated Half Dollar Quartet, VG to EF Details - 4 Coins. Includes 1854-O & 1856-O, VG and G-VG rim bump reverse; 1867-S, EF details, harshly cleaned with trace corrosion and pitting plus 1877, VG Fine. 4 coins.
- 57 US 1866 Seated Half Dollar, Choice Original Toned Borderline Unc to Unc. A lovely Reconstruction Era Half on the cusp of Mint State with toned Unc eye appeal and luster, only a few faint abrasions from a higher grade. A tougher With Motto example sporting both wholesome color and cartwheel bloom.
- 58 US 1871-CC Seated Half Dollar, Heavily Polished Good/VG, scs. Bright and very reflective, some old pin scratches on the reverse, nearly chromed in appearance. Scarce in all grades.
- 59 US 1875 Seated Half Dollar, Toned Choice VF-EF. A slightly better date and virtually EF with natural golden-gray toning.

- 60 US 1898-S, 1900, 1902 & 1909-S Barber Half Quartet, VG to Fine-VF. Grades range from VG to Fine-VF, cpl unevenly toned. 4 coins.
- 61 US 1906-1915 Mixed Date & Mint Barber Half Ensemble, Avg VG – 20 coins. Nice variety of dates and mints with only a few duplicates. Mostly toned and virtually all full rim reverses. 20 coins.
- 62 US 1914-S Barber Half Dollar Better Date, Nice Toned VF. Fully original and pleasing for the grade.
- 63 US 1916-1947-PDS Walking Liberty Half Dollar Set, no 1919-D&S Avg Circ to AU – 63 coins. A very near complete set in better than average condition, missing only the 1919-D&S examples. The early dates largely G-VG up until the 1921-PDS, which are AG-G, with the 1921-S exhibiting pin scs obverse. The balance of the set is VG to AU, with the 1938-D being VF+, some lt old cleanings in places, yet an appealing and attractive set. Housed in a deluxe Dansco album. 63 coins.
- 64 US 1917-1934 Better Date D & S Mint Walking Liberty Halves Lot, Avg Circ to VG – 14 coins. Features 1917-S Reverse, 1918-S(3), 1919-D, 1920-D(2), 1923-S, 1927-S(3), 1933-S & 1934-S. Mostly AG-Good to Fine, avg G-VG, the 1919-D and one 1927-S AG-Good. Some old cleanings, but many toned. 14 coins.
- 65 US 1917-1938 Key & Semi-Key Date Walker Half Dollar Lot, Avg Circ to Fine – 6 coins. Includes 1917-S obverse, 1919-D, 1921-S, 1929-S(2) and 1938-D. Avg circulated AG-Good to Fine, a few old cleanings. 6 coins.
- 66 US 1917-1947 Mixed Date & Mint Walking Liberty Halves Group, Avg Circ to VF-EF - 25 coins. Primarily 1930's-1940's dates with some duplication, mostly VG to VF, some cleaned yet largely original. 25 coins.
- 67 US 1936-D Walking Liberty Half Dollar, Lustrous Unc. Frosty with hints of golden toning.
- 68 US 1939-1947 Mixed Date & Mint Walking Liberty Halves, Avg EF-AU to AU – 8 coins. Features 1939-S, 1941-S, 1942(2), 1942-D, 1942-S(2) and 1947-D. Mostly ltly cleaned or dipped yet with luster remaining. 8 coins.
- 69 US 1941-1946 Walking Liberty Half Dollar Lot, Lustrous AU-Unc - 11 coins. Includes 1941, 1941-S, 1942(2), 1943(5), 1945 and 1946. Avg lustrous AU-Unc, some with pale golden or amber toning, cpl nice with the initial appearance of BU. 11 coins.
- 70 US 1941-D, 1943 & 1943-D Walking Liberty Halves, All ANACS MS64. All lustrous and largely white, the first with a couple small marks. 3 coins.
- 71 US 1942 Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS66 CAC Handsome Toning. Swirling luster with original russet-golden toning.
- 72 US 1942 Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS66 Ultra PQ Amber/Orange/Violet Color. Lovely frosty centers with outstanding peripheral toning – upgrade & CAC potential!
- 73 US 1942, 1942-D & 1942-S Walking Liberty Half Dollars, ANACS MS65/64/63. Virtually all white, the first two being very nice for the numerical grades. 3 coins.
- 74 US 1942-D Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS66 CAC Crescent Toning – Nice. Delicate lemon yellow to amber-orange crescent toning obverse with only a whisper of pale gold reverse.

- 75 US 1942-D Walking Liberty Half Dollar, NGC MS65 CAC Superb Originality OH Fat Slab. Gorgeous organic surfaces and luster in an early tombstone fat slab style holder.
- 76 US 1942-S, 1943-PDS, 1944 & 1945-PD Walking Liberty Halves, Lustrous Unc to Choice Unc. Nice frosty white to some colorfully toned examples. Neat lot. 7 coins.
- 77 US 1943 Walking Liberty Half Dollar, NGC MS66 CAC Fantastic Toning. Pearly pale ice blue to iridescent red-violet-golden hued toning over extraordinary cartwheel luster.
- 78 US 1943-S Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS65 CAC Iridescent Maroon Toning. A select quality San Francisco Mint Walker sporting unquestionable pristine natural toning.
- 79 US 1943-S Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS64. Razor sharp and blast white, looks 65 and flashy.
- 80 US 1944 Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS65 Ultra PQ Original Color. Lustrous pastel to stunning original golden-russet peripheral color, framing the obverse nicely.
- 81 US 1944-D, 1945-D & 1945-S Walking Liberty Half Dollars, ANACS MS64/62/64. Mostly creamy white and frosty/lustrous. 3 coins.
- 82 US 1944-S Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS67 Neon Toned Gem – Tied for Top Pop! A flashy and visually impressive jewel that appears atop the PCGS web listing True View images for this date! Neon lime green and magenta toning obverse over frothy luster paired with an arctic white reverse. A superb Gem with exemplary color and eye appeal. This coin should entice some aggressive bidding!
- 83 US 1945 Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS65 CAC Colorful Gem. Strong luster and beautiful golden to reddish colored fully original toning in an earlier pale blue insert slab, seemingly undergraded and handsome.
- 84 US 1945 Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS65. Ultra-fresh appearance with lovely originality and surfaces.
- 85 US 1945-D Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS66+ CAC Nicely Toned Jewel. Pristine cartwheel luster with stunning golden-russet hues obverse and reverse. A superb Gem that could potentially upgrade to 67 upon resubmission!
- 86 1945-S Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS66 CAC Killer Multicolor Toning. A stunner Wartime S-Mint Walker with impressive teal, gold and violet color over satiny lustrous fields and design elements. One could envision this sitting in a 67 holder quite easily.
- 87 US 1946 Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS65 CAC Toned Gem. Frosty luster awash in an array of reddish-golden iridescence, housed in an early plain blue insert slab with upgrade potential.
- 88 US 1946-D Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS66 CAC Luster & Color. Beautiful frosty shimmer with just a hint of pastel toning at the borders. Some hologram areas of weakness or voids on slab back panel.
- 89 US 1946-D Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS66 CAC Frosty with Crescent Toned Reverse. Dusty frosted white to crescent golden-violet toned Gem. Neat coin.
- 90 US 1946-D Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS65. Intricately struck pristine white Gem with a faint blush of translucent gold & violet.

- 91 US 1946-S Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS65 CAC Colorful Obverse. Stunning final year Gem of the San Francisco Mint Walkers with a delightful blush of blue, gold and violet toning obverse.
- 92 US 1947 Walking Liberty Half Dollar, NGC MS65 CAC Iridescent Reddish-Violet & Golden Toning. Dappled color articulates this Gem well-struck example of the final date of the series.
- 93 US 1947 & 1947-D Walking Liberty Half Dollar Pair, Choice Unc. Both with pale golden to gold and violet toning. 2 coins.
- 94 US 1947-D Walking Liberty Half Dollar, PCGS MS66 CAC Attractively Toned Gem. Lustrous and profoundly original surfaces approach an even higher grade level with hues of golden-orange iridescent toning.
