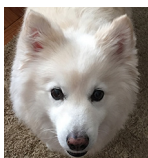

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TERMS OF SALE

(Please Read Carefully)

1. **ABSENTEE BIDS BY MAIL, EMAIL, PHONE or FAX** will be accepted until the deadline date as detailed within this catalog. All phone bids must be confirmed in writing on a signed bid sheet. Bids are treated as LIMITS. Bids are reduced where competition permits. In the case of tie bids, the first received is normally given preference. No "buy" or unlimited bids are accepted. Bids are accepted by lot number only. No lots are broken up. Bids are only executed in even dollars. No "either/or" nor "limit" bids.

2. **Items are sold AS IS.** Attribution, date, condition and other descriptions are only the opinion of the cataloguer, and no warranty is expressed or implied. Third party certified coins cannot be returned for any reason. **BIDDERS WHO VIEW MAY NOT RETURN ANY LOTS** including those purchased while acting as agents. All claims for adjustment by other bidders must be made within five days of receipt but in no case more than 30 days after a sale. As the auction house acts as an agent for various consignors, **NO CLAIM OF ANY KIND** can be considered after settlements have been made. If a claim is not made within this 30 day period, **NO lots are returnable** for any reason at any time. If we are notified prior to our settlement date that an opinion of condition, alteration or authenticity is being sought, the matter will remain open until such opinion is rendered. **Lots are not shipped until paid for in full.** Therefore, late payment will negate a return privilege. Any returned lot must be in its original holder with seal intact. **Chinese lots and all other miscellaneous, bulk, fantasy & multi-item lots are all NO RETURNS FOR ANY REASON.*

3. **Successful floor and mail bidders are required to pay the full invoice amount before lots are delivered. Terms of this sale are strictly cash.**

*****Please note: Should payment be made by check (in any form), the auctioneer reserves the right not to deliver lots until funds have cleared, usually 14 business days.** New clients are required to provide first rate credit references or a deposit to insure entry of your bids. Any portion of such a deposit not used will be promptly refunded after the sale. Any questions regarding this policy should be made in writing to the auctioneer 7 days prior to the sale date. Please contact us.

4. **Overseas Bidders Only:** Please bid in **U.S. Dollars.** Payment can be made via an agent in the U.S.A. or by wire transfer with a small added service charge. We do not accept credit card payments for lots. Special payment arrangements for wire transfer funding must be made in advance and extra charges will apply in many cases.

5. **A 17.5% buyer's fee will be added to the successful bid price of each lot bid via absentee bids, 20% for internet bids.** This 17.5% or 20% buyer's fee will be added to the invoice of each successful bidder without exception, and is payable by the buyer as part of the total purchase price. Additionally, 5% monthly interest is charged on all accounts 30 days past due calculated from the sale date. If any awarded lots are still on hand without a deposit 30 days after a sale, they will automatically be offered to the underbidders or relisted in the next available sale. The difference in price will be billed to the former bidder. Late payers should not expect to receive future listings.

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United States Coinage Colonials



- 1P. **Rare St. Patrick Halfpenny, c.1670.** Vlack 1-A as Breen-200. VG-Fine where struck up and design is present, a depression above the King and Harp with some faint old scs in that area, otherwise a very presentable example of this difficult to locate issue. *Ex: Goldberg's with original auction ticket.*

2. **Wood's Hibernia Halfpenny, 1724.** Die crack at date. VF, lt rb obverse.



- 3P. **Carolina Elephant Token Rarity of 1694.** PROPRIETORS O/E Variety. The unusual and legendary Halfpenny denomination thought to be struck in England to prompt the wealthy to establish Colonial plantations in South Carolina. Hodder 2-F, W-12120, R6, this being the variant with corrected spelling of PROPRIETORS reverse. PCGS Gold Shield Secure as Genuine, VF detail, environmental damage. Some routinely encountered fine planchet granularity/porosity and retoning quite nicely from a lt old cleaning. A showcase item for any Carolina collector and an important opportunity for the Colonial specialist, very low surviving population. *Ex: Kentfield Collection.*



- 4P. **Rhode Island Ship Token, ND(c.1780).** Betts-562, W-1730, R4. Nearly EF, a few old marks about the edge, otherwise sharp.

5. **Nova Contellatio, 1785.** Good, granular with slightly rough patina.

6. **Massachusetts Half Cent, 1787.** Pleasing VF.

7. **Massachusetts Cent, 1787.** Ryder 2b-A, the "Horned Eagle" variety. Fine, uniform dark brown color, cpl moderate edge marks obverse, otherwise pleasing.



- 8P. **Massachusetts Cent, 1788.** Ryder 11-C, R5. Fine/Fine-VF, some trivial flan striations and a small rb reverse. Very scarce. *Ex: Stack's with ticket.*

9. **Connecticut, 1787.** Horned Bust. Miller 4-L. Sharpness of Fine, typical mild porosity.



- 10P. **New Jersey 1788.** Maris 77-dd, R4. The "Running Fox" variety. Sharpness of VF, slightly granular yet appealing, cpl small rbs. Always sought after. *Ex: Peter Scherff Collection with Stack's ticket.*

11. **Vermont Copper, 1788.** Mailed Bust Right, Ryder 16. Handsome brown about VF, some faint uniform porosity. *Ex: E.A.H.A - Dana Linette.*



- 12P. **Franklin Press Token, 1794.** Breen-1165, W-8850. VF-EF.

13. **Franklin Press Token, 1794.** Breen-1165, W-8850. VF-EF, cpl rbs reverse.

14. **Talbot, Allum & Lee Cent, 1794.** Fine/VF, trace hints of lacquer and a few tiny rns.

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- 15P. **Washington & Independence Cent, Large Military Bust, 1783.** Baker-4, W-10210. EF, cpl tiny rns – otherwise nice and desirable.
16. Washington & Independence Cent, Draped Bust, No Button, 1783. VF.
17. Washington & Independence Cent, Draped Bust, No Button, 1783. VF, straight edge clip at 3 o'clock, cpl tiny rns.
18. Washington Double Head Cent, ND(c.1783). Baker-6, W-11200. Medium brown VF, small blunt old indent reverse yet appealing. *Ex: Stack's with ticket.*
19. Washington Double Head Cent, ND(c.1783). Baker-6 W-11200. Evenly colored dark steel bluish brown VF, a few random tiny marks/digs.
20. Washington Double-Headed Cent, 1783, cleaned F-VF, retoning and New Jersey, 1788, G-VG, flan striations and micro porosity. 2 coins.
21. North Wales Washington Halfpenny, c.1795. Baker 34. Fine-VF, flatly struck on a glossy medium brown flan. *Ex: Bowers & Ruddy and Coin Galleries with ticket.*



- 22P. **Fugio Cent, 1787. Newman 12-M, R3.** Nearly VF by wear, interesting curved clip to planchet. Nice two-tone patina with design elements lighter. *Ex: Goldberg's with ticket.*



- 23P. **Fugio Cent, 1787. Kessler 13-X, Pointed Rays.** VF-EF, retoning from a light old cleaning in shades of violet and reddish-brown.
24. **Colonial Study Lot Grouping of Coins, Tokens & Medals.** Features various electros and collector copies of Colonial Coins, tokens and medals including a Continental Dollar and Fugio Cent, Massachusetts Half Cent, Rhode Island Ship Token and William Pitt Medal, avg Fine to VF, some surface impairments and edge tooling. Also, Washington Collis Restrike(c.1959), B-22B Copper, NGC MS63RB along with fantasy/copy California Fractional Gold(2) and a curious Wells Fargo Civil War Ingot concoction, spuriously dated 1862, avg VF, one CA piece holed. An intriguing group. Viewing advised. 9 pcs.

25. **U.S. Colonial French John Law Coppers & More Crossover Selection.** Features John Law Coppers(16), avg circ to VF, some problematic and Silver 1/3 Ecu, 1720-W, VF, old cleaning and a few scattered marks plus 1721-W, VG, slight damage and deep sc rev. Also, Billon 30 Deniers & Sou Marque issues(3), deeply toned VF and Fine to nice VF-EF respectively. A very interesting and useful grouping. Viewing advised. 22 coins.

- 26P. **Sharply Detailed First Year 1793 Liberty Cap Half Cent.** PCGS Genuine – Environmental damage. This key one year type example presents itself with little evidence of any real environmental damage and is on the cusp of EF with sharp appointments and nice color – some fine old microscopic scs obv and a more notable one on the reverse all toned in wonderfully with age and patina so not detracting. A beautiful and well-struck example to the naked eye, excellent for an album type collection and will likely be reholdered at some point in the future. Worthy of resubmission.



- 27P. **Handsome Key First Year 1793 Liberty Cap Half Cent.** C-3, R3. Pleasing Fine and boldly defined. A nice example of this coveted one year type coin. *Ex: Tom Reynolds.*
28. 1803, C-1 Good+, old cleaning and trace porosity plus 1806, C-1, Fine. 2 coins.
29. 1805, No Stems, VG, cpl inclusions; 1809, VG, a few old pin scs; 1832, VF-EF; 1835(2), cld EF and holed Fine. Also, mixed date Large Cents, 1817-1853(15), Flying Eagle Cents(2) and Copper-Nickel Indian Cents(9), Fair to VF, many with damage or corrosion. Viewing advised. 31 coins.
30. 1806. No Stems. NGC AU details, cleaned – now retoning nicely.
31. 1809/6, C-5, VG, verdigris patch reverse; 1826, C-1, Good, corr and cpl lt scs; 1833, C-1, aVF and ½ Cent Token, 1837, Low-49, VF, trace verdigris/porosity. 4 coins.
32. 1811. Key date. C-2, R3. VG, cpl short old toned in pin scs, otherwise problem free and pleasing for the grade.
33. 1811. Key date. AG, old mark at date, lt porosity.
34. 1826. Handsome AU-Unc to Mint State with substantial red and a very attractive appearance.
35. 1828 13 Stars VF and 1855, Unc – both with iridescence in devices. 2 coins.
36. 1829, C-1, glossy brown Choice AU-Unc, scattered lt edge ticks and 1833, nice EF-AU. 2 coins.
37. 1833, C-1, attractive chestnut brown Choice EF and 1835, C-1, Choice EF, old marks efface "E" in Cent reverse, otherwise pleasing. 2 coins.

38. 1853. Glossy RB Unc, luster in devices.

- 41P. 1857. Key date final year of issue for the type and denomination. Lustrous brown Unc, nice hints of pretty teal/green color in devices. *Ex: Goldberg's.*
 42. 1857. Key date. EF+/EF.

- 43P. **Rare & Desirable 1793 Chain Cent.** S-4, B-5, R3. Period after LIBERTY and date. Early small ANACS slab as Fine15 and dark chocolate brown coloration. A strong, clearly defined date and a bold Chain & denomination reverse make this a wonderful example. Our very first American Cent and a short lived design, desired by all numismatists and collectors as the first of the firsts in the series. Sure to establish some emboldened bidding!



- 44P. **Scarce 1793 Wreath Cent, Lettered Edge.** NGC VG details, corrosion. Appearance is bold and strong, closely approaching Fine. Nice example for the grade range.



- 45P. **Nicely Detailed 1793 Wreath Cent, Vine & Bars Edge.** NGC VF details, corrosion. The coin actually looks VF-EF with uniform granularity and very sharply appointed to the naked eye.

- 46P. **Sharp 1793 Wreath Cent Rarity.** Vine and Bars Edge. S-8, R3. VF with pleasing color and a minimal number of marks from its light use in our nations early Federal Commerce. Neat example and historic. *Ex: EAC Auction. 4/4/1992.*
 47. Wreath Cent, No Date, Vine & Bars Edge, Fair/Poor, reverse nearly slick; 1794 Head of '93 and 1794 Head of '95, both Fair to Poor with dateless obverses and slick reverses. Also, 1796 Reverse of 1795, AG-Good/Poor but legible date. Neat early lot. 4 coins.
 48. Wreath Cent, No Date. Lettered Edge. Fair/Poor obverse nearly AG, some lt old marks reverse, bold and clear edge lettering.



- 49P. **Rarely Offered Better Grade 1793 Liberty Cap Large Cent.** S-13, B-20, R4. NGC VF details, environmental damage. Pleasing olive-brown and sharper than most of this rare type in existence with mildly uniform overall granularity. Quite strongly detailed for the coveted Cap variety and a tremendous opportunity to acquire this very seldom offered issue of the yellow fever epidemic era.
 50. 1794 Head of '94. S-29. VG-Fine sharpness, some scattered old toned in pin scs.
 51. 1795, Plain Edge. Appealing VG+ by wear, dark brown and slightly granular, an area of verdigris reverse.
 52. 1795 Lettered Edge. Dark brown Good-Good+, flan flaw error reverse.



- 53P. 1795, Stunning Jefferson Head Large Cent Electrotpe of S-80 Beautiful mahogany brown AU with very little base metal exposure and lustrous surfaces. Very desirable and seldom seen.
 54. 1796 LIHERTY Error Obverse. VG detail, old corr and granular surfaces with roughness. Still presentable for the variety.
 55. 1796 Reverse of '97. Full rim Good both sides, some random old marks.
 56. 1797. Gripped Edge, Reverse of 1795. Good-VG, uniform micro porosity, trace verdigris reverse.

57. 1797. Plain Edge, Reverse of 1795. Sharpness of aVF by wear, some areas of pitting, partly smoothed by old tooling. Still appealing.
58. 1797, Stemless Wreath, Good/AG-Good, some lt marks and a few lt scs and 1798/7, VG+ by wear, some micro pitting possibly smoothed yet desirable. 2 coins.
59. 1797, 1798, 1800/1798, 1800, 1801 and 1807(3). Nearly all different varieties, AG-Good to Fine details, some with corrosion, pitting, roughness or marks; cpl old cleanings or smoothing. Viewing advised. 8 coins.
60. 1798, Reverse of 1796, recolored Good/AG, some scattered tiny pits obverse and 1798, 2nd hairstyle, Fine by wear, numerous pin scs and micro porosity obverse, areas of verdigris reverse – otherwise pleasing. 2 coins.
61. 1800/1798. VF/Fine detail, cpl marks, some patches of corrosion/pitting and trace verdigris.

- 65P. 1802. S-227. Choice EF, Smooth glossy brown surfaces and sharply appointed, nearing the realm of AU.
66. 1802, S-230, sharpness of Fine, slight roughness, uniform brownish-black patina and 1812, S-290, area of flattening at edge, otherwise Fine detail, some brighter areas from an old cleaning. 2 coins.
67. 1802 Stemless Wreath. VG.
68. 1802 Normal Reverse, G-VG, scattered small marks and 1802 Fraction 1/000, VG-VG+, some lt old marks. 2 coins.
69. 1803. Small Date, Small Fraction. S-254. Nearly VF by wear, cpl lt rbs.
70. 1803 Large Cent Variety Quartet. Includes Small Date, Large Fraction VG-Fine sharpness, some lt old pin scs Large Date, Large Fraction, AG+, pin scs and rbs; Fraction 1/100 over 1/000, AG-Good, old scrapes/marks and Stemless Wreath, AG-Good. 4 coins.



- 71P. **1804. Key Date Large Cent, MDS.** Good, strong date, retoning from an old cleaning. Some faint signs of tooling obverse field. Very presentable with substantial “meat” for the grade of this rare and popular issue.



- 72P. **1804. Key Date Large Cent.** Smooth dark brown AG, a few small marks yet strong, bold date.



- 73P. **1804 Large Cent Restrike.** EF-AU and always sought after 1860's reissue enigma.

74. 1805, S-269, dark brown VG-Fine, scattered lt marks and small verdigris pit above bow in hair obverse, otherwise glossy and nice along with 1806, S-270, AG-G/Good-VG. 2 coins.

75. 1807. Comet S-271. Sharpness of Good-VG, some stray old marks.

76. 1808, Sharpness of Fine/VF, blackish-brown color with patches of corr and old pin scs. Also, 1809, 1810, 1812 and 1814, avg AG-Good with surface problems, one with flattening and cpl with old pin scs. 5 coins.

77. 1810/09. VF by wear, some minor roughness and fine porosity yet still quite pleasing.

78. 1811/10, AG-G, old indent at center; 1811, slightly off-center, finely porous dark VG-Fine and 1814, handsome smooth brown VG/Good. 3 coins.

79. 1812. Appearance of smooth brown aVF/VF, cpl faint old toned in pin scs. Appealing for the type.

80. 1813. Dark brown aVF, slightly burnished glossy brown surfaces.



- 81P. 1816. N-4. Handsome brown EF. A wonderful first year Coronet Cent example. *Ex: Rod Burress.*

82. **1816, 1817 & 1818 Collector Grade Album of Newcomb Die Variety Coronet Large Cents.** Features 1816: N-6, N-7 and N-8; 1817: N-1 to N-17 complete along with three 1818 examples. Good to VF-EF, mostly VG to bold Fine-VF. Some typically encountered surface issues yet a nice grouping housed in a Dansco album. Viewing advised, specialized collector value present. A cool group with more than half VG-Fine to VF and Sharp. 23 coins.

83. 1817, 13 Stars, slightly granular aEF; 1834, Lg. 8, Small Stars/ Medium Letters, PCGS Fine details, cleaned; 1850, glossy brown aEF, lt scattered contact and 1853, iridescent retoned aEF-EF. 4 coins.



- 84P. 1818. N-7. Attractive chocolate brown AU. Nice type coin.

85. 1818. N-7. Definition of a nice EF-AU, mellowing to red and brown color form a lt old cleaning, luster remains.



- 86P. 1818. N-10. Virtually Unc, underlying luster and glossy brown. Great type coin.



- 87P. 1818. N-10. Choice EF-AU, hints of reddish-tan in protected areas. An attractive type piece.



- 88P. **Lovely 1821 Large Cent Key Issue Jewel Toned Example.** N-1. Steel bluish-brown sharp iridescent AU, approaching the appearance of Unc, some very faint smoothing/hairlines well-concealed beneath the toning, yet very attractive. *Ex: Hips and an exemplary example of the key middle date issue.*

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- 90P. 1823/2. PCGS older blue insert VF20. Scarce and popular straight graded overdate.

92. 1823/2 and 1823, both AG-Good, cpl old marks/rbs; 1824/2, solid full rim Good-VG and 1826/5, glossy VG, some small flan flaws and marks, rbs. 4 coins.



- 93P. 1825. N-2, R2. Sharp EF, high points slightly lighter in coloration.

94. 1827, N-3 VG/F roughness and verdigris; 1833, N-6, VG+, lt tooling and porosity; 1837, N-13, nice about VF/VF and 1838, N-9, VG/Fine, scattered lt marks. Also, 1843, N-9 and 1844, N-1, G-VG trace verdigris and Fine respectively. 6 coins.

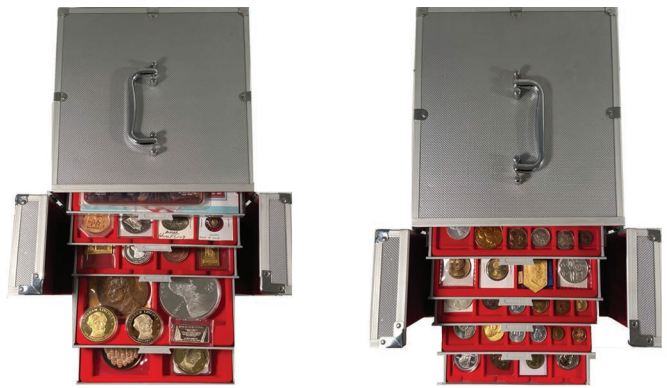

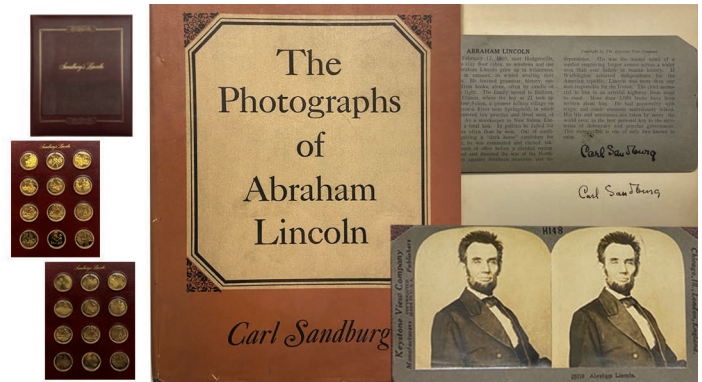
