George would bring Type Set Folders including several coins to coin shows and would hand them out to young collectors. George gave away coins to neighboring children, encouraging them to join the numismatic world. George enjoyed showing and teaching the history and importance of coins. He would bring a specific collection group to a coin club meeting or coin show to help educate and stimulate collectors. At coin shows collectors from near and far would stop at George's tables to chat with him. You could see their eyes light up with enthusiasm discussing numismatics as he shared his experiences and knowledge. George was a treasured member of the Lincoln Coin Club; he joined as a teenager in 1959 and was very active the last decade.

In recent years, a collector friend encouraged George to put together a PCGS Registry Set. He decided it would be Barber Quarters since the Barber series is a favorite. With typical George form he jumped into that arena. George put together the \#1 PCGS AU Barber Quarter Registry Set in the World.

I had the pleasure to work with George at the coin shows the last 6 years. I was the "muscle" and he was the "brains". Since my muscle wasn't as strong as his brains, George suggested we bring aboard two of my sons to work with us the last couple of years.
