

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT HOW TO START THE ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Step 1: Provide PSA with the following documents

- 1. Scanned color copy of your Passport
- 2. Completed Student Registration Form
- 3. Signed copy of Professional Pilot Training Cost Agreement
- 4. Pay the Application & Registration of \$500
- 5. Prepare for the initial deposit

Step 2: Once the above documents are received by PSA then PSA will provide the following

- 1. A Letter of Acceptance into the program
- 2. An original I20 (signed by the school)
- 3. Signed copy of Professional Pilot Training Cost Agreement

Step 3: Once you receive the above documents, schedule your VISA interview

- 1. Pay the I-901 Fees (SEVIS fees) online
- 2. Schedule your Visa interview online with the US Embassy Consulate
- 3. Go for the Visa interview take all your documents
- 4. Once approved pay visa fees and get the visa
- 5. Advise PSA that you received the visa
- 6. Advise PSA about your expected arrival date
- 7. Arrival date should be prior to your start date on the I20

Step 4: Once you arrive at our PSA

- 1. PSA will pick you up from the airport
- 2. Your housing will be ready (if you have requested it)
- 3. You will directly go to your housing and rest for that day

Step 5: Next day after your arrival

- 1. Meet the Chief Flight Instructor for all your verifications & enrollment
- 2. PSA briefing and tour of academy & ramp safety will be conducted
- 3. Receive all your pilot supplies (kits, uniform, headsets, etc.)
- 4. Set up student account with dispatch (schedule program, etc.)
- 5. Finish up paperwork with dispatch

Step 6: Student Services will help with the following

- 1. Take you to open a US bank account
- 2. Assist you getting a local cell phone number
- 3. Complete online application for FAA Medical
- 4. Set up a FAA Medical appointment
- 5. Complete the TSA application and pay the TSA fees online
- 6. Make an appointment for finger printing (required by TSA)

Step 7: Starting Training

- 1. Apply for a Student Pilot License (FAA Medical required)
- 2. Assign a Flight Instructor
- 3. If Part 141 training Issue and Enrollment Certificate
- 4. STUDENT IS NOW READY TO START TRAINING
- 5. Can start ground training without TSA approval
- 6. Start flight training after receiving TSA approval
