## **ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS**

- Hold a current FAA Medical Certificate
- Be least 18 years of age
- Hold a U.S. Private Pilot or Commercial Certificate with Airplane Single Engine Land
- Hold Instrument Rating (not required)
- Be able to read, write, speak, and understand English Language

#### **ESTIMATED TRAINING HOURS**

- 15 hours of Dual Flight Training in Multi Engine Airplane
- 15 hours of Ground and Pre-Post Training and Briefing
- 2 hours of Solo Multi Engine Airplane Flight for FAA Check Ride
- Duration of Training 2 to 3 weeks
- Multi Engine Simulator is Optional

### **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

Pass the FAA Practical Test (Oral & Flight Check)

### **COST OF FLIGHT & GROUND**

- Current hourly rental rate for Simulator is \$75/hour (without Instructor)
- Current hourly rental rate for Multi Engine Aircraft is \$415/hour (without Instructor)
- Current hourly Flight Instructor rate is \$105/hour (for flight and ground training)
