- Hold an Instrument Rating for appropriate category and class
- Be able to read, write, speak, and understand English Language

- 15 hours of Dual Flight Training in Multi Engine Airplane
- 10 hours of Ground and Pre-Post Training and Briefing
- Duration of Training 2 Weeks or less (Full Time Student)

Pass the FAA Practical Test (Oral & Flight Check)

Should be able to teach ground and flight lessons within or better than FAA standards
