



## AI Policy at The Indus Auguries

### Policy Overview

1. **No AI-Generated Content:** We maintain a strict policy against accepting or publishing content that artificial intelligence tools have created, generated, or substantially modified. The content we accept encompasses written text alongside images and poetry, as well as scholarly essays and all other forms of creative work.
2. **Human Authorship Requirement:** We accept only original content authored by human writers for all submissions. Journal contributors must declare through submission that their work emerged from their minds without AI tool assistance during the conception, writing and/or editing process.
3. **Transparency and Verification:** Any suspicion of AI tool involvement that affects submitted work allows *The Indus Auguries* to ask authors for additional information on their creative methods. Failure to provide the requested information may lead to submission rejection.
4. **Upholding Integrity:** Participation in future submissions at *The Indus Auguries* journal may be restricted to contributors who violate the policy regarding AI-generated work submissions. Our publication's integrity remains essential because it ensures the trust of readers along with our contributors.

5. Turnitin AI-Detector: *The Indus Auguries* relies on Turnitin AI-Detector to confirm if the content was AI-generated or not, and the acceptable score for AI-report is 0%.
