The Potter Pirates baseball team was started by Jeff Potter. Jeff was a star baseball player in high school and spent time in the Detroit Tigers minors league system directly after high school. He continued to love baseball throughout his life, and for the last 15 years, used baseball as a vehicle to help teenagers and adults learn valuable life lessons through working together and giving of themselves for the benefit of others. Jeff lived by four key tenets that he believed in deeply: passion, respect, selflessness, and hard work. Each year, coach Potter's baseball tour would travel around to various communities cleaning up baseball fields, teaching kids at local leagues the fundamentals of baseball, and promoting the game of baseball by demonstrating their deep love of the game. Sadly, Coach Potter passed away in June 2024. He touched thousands of lives and helped develop young teenagers into caring and strong adults who continue to carry forth his legacy. The team still plays in Cooperstown in his honor.

Each year Potter Baseball creates teams of baseball players from all over the country who are 11-12 years old and provides them with the opportunity of a lifetime to play at Cooperstown Dreams Park. This 22-field facility is located just a short 20-minute drive from the birthplace of baseball, Cooperstown, NY. This unique experience is a capstone event for 12U baseball players and draws thousands of players, parents, and coaches to the quiet town in upstate New York every summer from April through August. Cooperstown Dreams Park is also the home of the American Youth Baseball Hall of Fame, and every player that plays in a Cooperstown Dreams Park tournament is inducted as a AYBHOF member at the close of the tournament. Many professional players (Bryce Harper, Kyle Schwarber, Jacob DeGrom, and Mike Trout just to name a few) have made this journey to "Live the Dream" at CDP.

The 2026 Potter Pirates White team will begin their baseball dream week on August 5th, 2026, and play a minimum of 6 games between August 6th and 11th. This 6-day tournament will draw approximately 100 teams from all over the United States and Canada. All the players and coaches stay in bunks on the tournament complex during the entire tournament. They literally eat, sleep, and play baseball (and wiffle ball in between games) for 6 days. They also get to trade pins in their free time.

As you can imagine, the expense of this trip is significant, and we are looking for help from company and community sponsors to cover some of the expense. First and foremost, we are looking to cover the cost of 3 coaches that must pay to stay in a 10' x 20' bunkhouse with twelve 11/12-year-old boys for 6 days. Additionally, we are looking to cover the cost of the pins that the kids will trade during their time at CDP. The fancier and more "blinged out" the pins, the more valuable they become in the pin trade game, this enhances the experience for the kids. Other expenses to cover are umpire fees, team shirts, team banner, and a team party at the end of the tournament.
