All persons on club property are responsible for their safety and the safety of others. Becoming familiar with PCSC, both its physical and operational policies, is crucial to the safety and enjoyment for all.

Certainly we stress:

**SAFETY FIRST - ENJOYMENT SECOND**

To certify that you are legally able to possess a firearm in the State of Texas, the Club asks that you provide one of the following:

1. A signed and identifiable receipt from an FFL of a recent firearm purchase.
2. A valid Texas CHL license.
3. A report from a Texas Dept. of Public Safety criminal background search with no record of a felony or domestic violence. Please be prepared to provide a copy of above. This is available at:

In the interest of introducing you to the Club's physical grounds we will provide a tour of the facility at orientation.

To stress the importance of safety and care of facility we have provided you with a classroom instruction that is uniform for all new members.

You are provided an open-book review that is designed to show your knowledge of the club rules.

To help introduce yourself to the club and to one another you will attend and participate in 2 club functions as part of your provisional membership. You'll get first-hand training in the actual operation of a firing line during the service rifle match. You'll receive training on the proper and safe operation of the automated trap and skeet equipment, if you so choose to use the trap and skeet fields. Attending a Board Meeting will expose you to the process by which the elected leaders of the Club manage the affairs of PCSC. There are numerous tasks that leadership needs assistance with that can count towards your full membership as well including but not limited to administrative or construction projects.

Please keep this invitation in a safe place and have the presiding officer, director, or sponsor of an event sign-off on each function that you attend. After attending at least two events and

having your attendance signed off, return this letter to PCSC at PO Box 424, Weatherford Texas, 76087 ATTN Manager / New Member.

Please keep a copy for your records.

Upon completion of the above-mentioned tasks you will then become a full member and be able to purchase a Guest Membership privilege and enjoy other benefits of full membership.
