## A Little About Us

Parker County Sportsman Club is a private shooting range West of the Dallas/Fort Worth metroplex. We are a non-profit organization incorporated in 1956. Four officers and eight directors volunteer for and manage the club. Various contract administrators and numerous committee members serve the club. We are located about 5 miles west of Poolville, TX.

Our club offers fine rifle, pistol, and shotgun ranges to meet member needs. The clubhouse and heated restrooms are surrounded by a graveled parking area. The range is open from legal sunup to sundown 7 days a week, 365 days a year. We utilize a bulletin board for current events at the clubhouse and sign-in hut. An emailed monthly newsletter keeps members informed of activities. We provide a contact form on [www.parkersportsman.com](http://www.parkersportsman.com) website. We have two supply storage buildings to keep the maintenance items in good shape. There is a clubhouse and a larger activity building. There are 9 ranges: Pistol 50 Feet, Falling Steel Plate 25 yds, Rifle and Pistol 50 yards, Rifle 100 yards and Rifle 275 yards, Manual Trap, Automated Trap and Skeet, Sporting Clays and Five Stand.

We work hard as committed members to make it safer and more enjoyable for all. We have shooting events and swap meets throughout the year. Monthly light dinner (6:30 pm) and board meeting (7:00 pm) is on the third Thursday night of the month. We meet at the Clubhouse, 6700 Advance Road, NW Parker County, Texas. Come out and voice your ideas. Remember it is your club and it is only as safe and good as you make it. All this for only \$100\* per year, nonrefundable, when renewed promptly and no notes from mother needed!
