



LIABILITY WAIVER & PHOTO PERMISSION

Legal and insurance requirements are necessary in this environment, but we've developed two tools that will make your Chapter's efforts to cover all your bases easy. Essentially, your chapter needs to find a way for the parent or guardian to agree to the below Photo Permission and General Release of Liability, either at the point where they register the kids or on site when they check in.

You must use this "Photo Permission and General Release of Liability" statement in one of two ways:

1. When the parent/guardian registers the attending child/children, OR
2. When the parent/guardian checks in the attending child/children on site at your event.

Required statement:

Photo Permission and General Release of Liability: I hereby authorize WAI and its affiliates to publish any photographs or videos taken of me or my minor child(ren) for use in WAI's printed publications, website, and other mediums, and for training purposes. I release WAI and its affiliates from any expectation of confidentiality and attest by my signature that I am the parent or legal guardian of the child(ren) listed and that I have authority to permit WAI to use said photographs and/or video for promotional and training purposes. I acknowledge that participation in the event is voluntary. I acknowledge that WAI confers no rights in photos and/or video of my minor child(ren) and that neither me nor my minor child(ren) will receive financial or other compensation for use of such photo and/or video. I hereby release WAI and its affiliates from liability for any and all claims that may arise in connection with participation in the Girls in Aviation Day event, including but not limited to liability that may arise from any related publication or broadcast.

Using the statement in advance, at registration: If your chapter is using an online tool such as Eventbrite, or other tool, you can structure your registration process so that the adult who is registering the kids, by way of completing the registration, is agreeing to the above statement. We recommend using this to simplify your check-in process on site at your event.

On-Site at your event: If you're not using an advance registration process, or if you have walk ups, you will need to have each parent/guardian sign in each child using the provided GIAD Sign-In Sheet.
