NATIONAL STRATEGY

We were pleased to lead national research on Local Skills Improvement Plans (LSIPs) for the British Chambers of Commerce in 2024.

Building on our knowledge and experience of working with the Thames Valley Chamber of Commerce on the Berkshire and Oxfordshire LSIPs, the research was based on evidence from 21 chamber led LSIPs. The study highlights the "huge potential of LSIPs to build on the employer led system, improve strategic planning, maximise the impact of skills funding and boost employer investment." Jane Gratton, Deputy Director Public Policy at the British Chambers of Commerce said:

"Business-led Local Skills Improvement Plans (LSIPs) are only just getting started – but they are already making a huge difference. Our report highlights how the Chamber network is playing an important role in bringing employers and training providers together at a local level, to identify solutions and plan for change."

The innovative College Collective, in partnership with the Association of Colleges, is a growing movement of colleges working together to promote sector-led consultancy.

We have significantly increased the number of opportunities for our partner colleges to engage in Collective activity this year, particularly through our Action Learning sets and Wisdom of Colleges sessions.

The engagements include 68 matches from Experts, 75 staff receiving support, 118 staff registered to attend Action Learning Sets and 113 staff registered to attend Wisdom sessions, which gives a total of 374 staff engagements.

BESPOKE WORKSHOPS


